Hand Sew/ing-ma-chine!. A form of sewing-machine in which the parts are pivoted jaws, operated in the manner of scissors. The machine illustrated employs two threads to form a lock-stitch. The looping-hook E' makes a reciprocating instead of a continuous revolution around the disk bobbin F. The bobbin and looping-hook are contained in one part, and the eye-pointed needle N is attached to the other portion. There are other forms.
