I'ron-ing-ma-chine'. One for ironing clothes, etc. Specific forms are make for hat-ironing, for hosiery, and for tailors. The example shows one in which the clothes are carried on the endless belt under the heated roller. The table is depressible to allow the passage of heavy articles. The roller cover is the bottom of the fire-chamber, and the fire is urged by air from a blower driven by the crank which carries the endless apron.
