

The shuttle (Fig. 6229) has a pin *b* which is protracted by a thumb-piece to pass a thread through a loop, and is retracted by a spring.

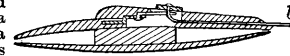


Tatting-Shuttle.

Tatting-shuttle Wind'er. A device for holding and rotating the tatting-shuttle while the thread is guided between the prongs of the shuttle.

One plate of the shuttle is clamped by sliding sleeves on a bar attached to a rotating shaft in a handle which carries a spool of thread, which is thus transferred to the bobbin of the shuttle.

Tatting-shuttle. A small shuttle used in *tatting*.

Fig. 6228 has a sheathed spool with a spring at each end. A tatting-hook at one end of the shuttle may be protruded or sheathed at pleasure.
