

To Remove Stains from Linen.

To remove stains from linen, such as wine, fruit, or rust, a solution of hyposulphite of soda is applied to the spots, and, when thoroughly soaked, enough strong vinegar is added to cover the stain; pulverized tartaric acid will be better than vinegar, if spread on the spots. Leave the spots for a short time to be acted upon by these chemicals, and then wash out in plenty of soft water.
