

Cam'let, *n.* [Fr. *camelot*; Gr. *kamēlō-tē*.] Literally, a camel's skin, or a garment made of the same. A stuff originally made of camel's hair, now made chiefly of wool or goat's hair. (Sometimes written *camelot*.)
