

Spinning-wheel, n. A wheel formerly employed in the domestic spinning of material for textile fabrics; it consisted of a wheel which worked with the foot by means of a treddle, gave motion to a spindle, on which the thread or yarn spun by the fingers was wound.

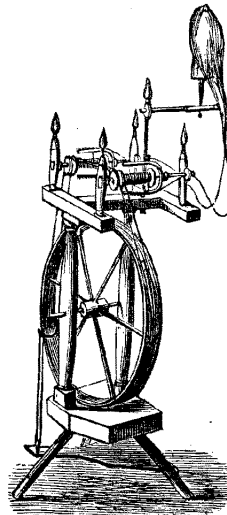
