## Baby Set "SO YOUNG"

**MATERIALS**—Jack Frost Baby Yarn (1 oz. balls):—2-balls White and 4-balls Lt. Blue or Pink. CRAZY DAISY WINDER. Crochet hook size 3. 3-yds.  $\frac{3}{4}$ " ribbon and 30" narrow baby ribbon. Size—2 to 9 months.

**BONNET**—Daisy—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind colored yarn once around each spoke of Winder. Cut 14" long. Then wind once more around each spoke with White yarn and cut 1" long. Thread 14" end of colored yarn to a needle and weave center as in Ill. E, making a 12-petal flower with one colored lp (on front) and one White lp (on back) in each petal. Make 13 Daisies for Bonnet, 99 for Jacket and 8 for Booties.

**BLOCK**—In colored yarn, sc thru both lps of one petal, \* (ch 5, sc in next petal) 3 times, ch 7, sl st in last sc for a corner p. Repeat from \* around. End with a sl st in 1st sc, ch 7, sl st in same st, cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat to 1st corner. In place of 7-ch p, ch 3, sl st thru 1 lp of the center st of a corner p on 1st Block, ch 3, a sl st back

## Best Bib'n Tucker BABY SET

(Illustrated at right)

**MATERIALS**—Jack Frost Baby Yarn (1-oz. balls) in Lt. Blue or Pink:—2-balls for Cap and Cape, 3-balls for Carriage Robe; Lily Pearl Cotton size 5 (50-yd. balls):—11-balls White for Cap and Cape, 15-balls for Robe. CRAZY DAISY WINDER. Crochet hook size 5. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ -yds. ribbon. 1—small pearl button. Size—9-months to 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  years.

**DAISY**—Following instruction on page 2, Illustration C, wind Baby Yarn twice around each spoke of Winder. Cut 1" long and weave center with White Pearl Cotton as in Illustration E, making a 12-petal flower with 2 lps in each petal. Make 216-Daisies for Carriage Robe, 17 for Cap and 122 for Cape.

**BLOCK**—In Pearl Cotton, make 1 sc thru both lps of one petal, \* ch 5, sc in next petal, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 7, 2 dc) all in next petal, ch 3, sc in next petal. Repeat from \* 3 times, ending with a sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten securely on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat to 1st corner. Instead of corner 7-ch, make 3-ch, sl st thru 1 lp of the center st of a corner 7-ch on 1st Block, ch 3, 2 dc back in same petal, ch 1, sl st in next 3-ch lp on 1st Block, ch 1, sc back in next petal, ch 2, sl st in next 5-ch lp

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in last sc to complete joining p, (ch 2, sl st in next 5-ch lp on 1st Block, ch 2, sc back in next petal) 3 times, ch 3, sl st thru 1 lp of the center st of next corner p on 1st Block, ch 3, a sl st back in last sc to complete joining p and complete Block as for 1st one. Continue to join Blocks in same way. Join 12 Blocks (2 x 6 rows) into a straight Band (see Chart).

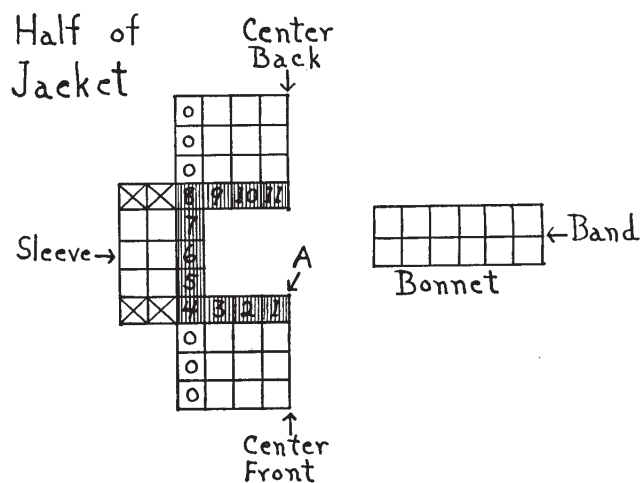
**Back Circle**—Sc in colored yarn in 1 petal of a Daisy, (ch 5, sc in next petal) 11 times, ch 5, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, (5 dc in next lp, 1 dc in sc) repeated around, sl st in 1st 3-ch. **ROW 3**—(Ch 5, sc in next 2d dc) 36 times. Sl st to center of 1st lp. **ROW 4**—Join to one long side of Band in this row:—(Ch 5, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 2, sl st in corner p on Band, ch 2, sc back in next lp on Circle, \* (ch 2, sl st in next lp on Band, ch 2, sc back in next lp on Circle) 3 times, (ch 2, sl st in side of next corner p on Band, ch 2, sc back in next lp on Circle) twice. Repeat from \* around to other corner of Band. (Ch 5, sc in next lp on Circle) 3 times. Sl st to center of next lp.

**Edge**—Ch 6, tr in next lp, ch 1, tr in next lp, ch 1, dtr in next half-lp, ch 1, dtr in side of next corner p, ch 1, dc in next lp across end of Band, ch 2, sc in next lp, ch 6, sc in next lp, \* ch 6, sc in joining of Blocks, (ch 6, sc in next lp) 3 times, \* ch 6, sc in corner p, (ch 6, sc in next lp) 3 times. Repeat from \* to \* across Band and around to center of end of Band. (Ch 6, sc in next lp) twice, ch 2, dc in next lp, ch 1, dtr in side of next p, ch 1, dtr in next half-lp, (ch 1, tr in next lp) 3 times, ch 1, sl st in 5th st of 1st 6-ch, sc in next 1-ch sp. **ROW 2**—(Ch 6, sk 2 tr, sc in next 1-ch sp) twice, (ch 6, sc in next 6-ch lp) 6 times, ch 6, dc in corner sc, (ch 6, sc in next lp) repeated across, ch 6, dc in corner sc, (ch 6, sc in next lp) 6 times, ch 6, sk next dc, sc in next 1-ch sp, (ch 6, sk 2 tr, sc in next 1-ch sp) 3 times. Fasten off.

**Trim**—In colored yarn, ch 8, tr in starting st, (ch 8, tr in starting st of this 8-ch) 24 times. Ch 5, turn, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in each 7-ch lp across. Ch 5, sl st in starting st. Fasten off. Sc back in 1st 5-ch in last row, \* ch 5, sl st thru 1 lp of 4th ch st from hook for a p, (ch 4, a p) twice, ch 1, sc in center of next shell. Repeat from \* across to 5-ch at other end. Lay base of this Trim around front edge of Bonnet, exactly matching lps. Ch 7, 2 dtr thru 1st lp on both pieces, (ch 2, 2 dtr thru next lp on both pieces) repeated to other end, ch 7, sc in corner, (ch 2, 2 sc in next lp) 19 times around neck, ch 2, 7 sc in next 7-ch lp, (sc in 2 dtr, 2 sc, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p, and 1 sc,—all in next 2-ch sp) repeated across to corner, 7 sc in end 7-ch, sc in sc, (2 sc in next 2-ch, sc in 2 sc) repeated around neck. Fasten off. Block to desired size. Run 1-yd. of ribbon thru beading around front.

**JACKET—Yoke**—Sc in colored yarn in 1 petal of a Daisy, \* (ch 5, sc in next petal) 11 times, ch 5, sl st in 1st sc and fasten off. **2d DAISY**—Repeat to \*. (Ch 5, sc in next petal) 10 times, \*\* ch 2, sl st in 1 lp on 1st Daisy, ch 2, sc back in next petal, ch 2, sl st in next lp on 1st Daisy, ch 2, sl st back in 1st sc and fasten off. **3d DAISY**—Repeat last Daisy to \*\*. Ch 2. Counting from joining of last 2 Daisies, leave 3 lps free on last Daisy, then make sl st in next lp, ch 2, sc back in next petal, ch 2, sl st in next lp on other Daisy, ch 2, sl st back in 1st sc and fasten off. Join 6 more Daisies as for 3d Daisy, making a curved row, with 3 free lps on top of each Daisy between joinings and 5 around the bottom of each. **Edge**—In colored yarn make (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in each 5-ch lp all around Yoke. Join and fasten off.

To join shaded Blocks (see Chart) to Yoke, start with 1st Block on Right Front:—\*\* Sc in colored yarn in 1 petal of a Daisy, \* (ch 5, sc in next petal) 3 times, ch 7, sl st in last sc. \*\* Repeat from \* once. (Ch 5, sc in next petal) twice, ch 8, sc in next petal, ch 5, sl st in 4th shell around bottom of Daisy at right end of Yoke (counting from joining of 1st 2 Daisies in Yoke), ch 1, sc back thru all 4 lps of next 2 petals, ch 1, sl st in same shell on Yoke, ch 5, sl st back in 1st sc, ch 3, sl st in next shell on Yoke, ch 3, sl st back in same sc and fasten off. **2d BLOCK**—Repeat 1st Block from \*\* to \*\*. (Ch 5, sc in next petal) 3 times, ch 3, sl st in lower corner p of last Block, ch 3, sl st back in last sc, (ch 2, sl st in next lp up side of last Block,



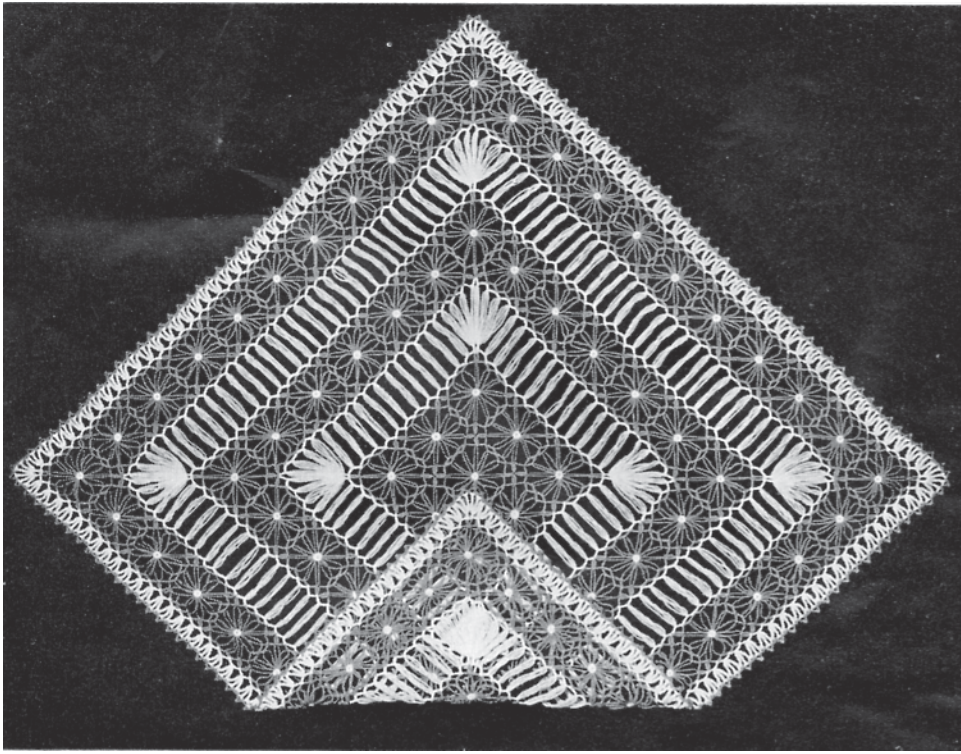
ch 2, sc back in next petal) 3 times, \* ch 3, sl st in same shell on Yoke where last Block was joined, ch 3, sl st back in last sc, \*\* ch 5, sl st in next shell on Yoke, ch 1, sc back thru all 4 lps of next 2 petals, ch 1, sl st in same shell on Yoke, ch 5, sc back in 1st sc, \*\* ch 5, sl st in next shell on Yoke, ch 5, sl st back in same sc and fasten off. **3d BLOCK**—Repeat 2d Block to \*. Ch 5, sl st in 1st shell on next Daisy of Yoke, ch 5, sl st back in last sc. Repeat 2d Block from \*\* to \*\*. Ch 3, sl st in next shell on Yoke, ch 3, sl st back in same sc and fasten off. **4th (Corner) BLOCK**—Repeat 2d Block to 1st \*\*. (Ch 5, sc in next petal) twice, ch 5, (sl st, ch 7, sl st) in 1st sc and fasten off. **5th BLOCK**—Repeat 2d Block. **6th BLOCK**—Repeat 3d Block. **7th BLOCK**—Repeat 2d Block. **8th (Corner) BLOCK**—Repeat 2d Block to \*. Ch 5, sl st between shells in angle between Daisies of Yoke, ch 5, sl st back in last sc, (ch 5, sc in next petal) twice, ch 5, (sl st, ch 7, sl st) in 1st sc and fasten off. **9th BLOCK**—Repeat 2d Block to \*. Ch 4, sl st in 1st shell on next Daisy of Yoke, ch 4, sl st back in last sc. Repeat 2d Block from \*\* to \*\*. Ch 3, sl st in next shell on Yoke, ch 3, sl st back in same sc and fasten off. **10th BLOCK**—Repeat 2d Block. **11th BLOCK**—Repeat 3d Block. This completes half of row. Make other half in same way, repeating next Blocks 2, 3, 2, 8, 9, 2, 3, 4, 2 and 3. **Final BLOCK**—Sc in 1 petal, ch 8, sc in next petal, (ch 5, sc in next petal) twice, ch 7, sl st in last sc, (ch 5, sc in next petal) 3 times, ch 3, sl st in lower corner p of last Block, ch 3, sl st back in last sc, (ch 2, sl st in next lp up side of last Block, ch 2, sc back in next petal) 3 times. Repeat 2d Block from \* to 2d \*\*. Sl st to 3d st of next 8-ch lp, ch 2, turn, dtr in same shell where Block was joined, ch 5, dc in next shell, ch 5, sc in next shell. Fasten off. Join colored yarn to 8-ch corner lp A on Chart, ch 2, dtr down in same shell on Yoke where 1st Block was joined, ch 5, dc in next shell, ch 5, sc in next shell and fasten off.

Make and join 34 more Blocks (see Chart), following directions for 2d Block of Bonnet. Leave center front open. Join [X]-Blocks to close Sleeves. Join [o]-Blocks on sides of Fronts and Back under arms.

**Edge**—Join colored yarn to corner p at bottom of Right Front, ch 3, (1 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same p, \* (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in each of next 3 lps up Front, sc in joining of Blocks. Repeat from \* twice. (A shell in next lp) 3 times, sc in next dtr, (a shell in next lp) twice, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next (corner) shell, (a shell in next shell) twice, (ch 2, tr in next 2 shells, ch 2, a shell in next shell) 8 times around neck, a shell in next shell, make corner and work down front as on other side. Make a shell in corner p, (a shell in each of next 3 lps, sc in joining of Blocks) repeated around bottom and join. Sl st to center of 1st shell. **ROW 2**—\* Ch 5, sl st thru 1 lp of 4th ch st from hook for a p, (ch 4, a p) twice, ch 1, sc in next shell. Repeat from \* up to 1st shell at neck corner, a p-lp, tr in next shell, (ch 5, p, ch 4, p, ch 1, tr in next shell) twice, (a 2-p lp, tr between next 2 tr, a 2-p lp, tr in next shell) 8 times, (a 2-p lp, tr in next shell) twice, (a 3-p lp, sc in next shell) repeated down front and around bottom. Join and fasten off.

**Cuff**—Sc in joining of 2 Blocks, (a shell in each of next 3 lps, sc in joining of Blocks) repeated around. Sl st to center of 1st shell. Ch

## No. 16 *Daisy Scarf* "ON THE SQUARE"

**MATERIALS**—Jack Frost Fleecy Zephyr (2-fold yarn):—a 1-oz. skein each of White and a color. Crochet hook size 3. **CRAZY DAISY WINDER.** Size—30-inches square.

**DAISY**—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration D, wind color around Winder, cut 1" long and weave center with White as in Ill. E, making 25 sts (2 rows) around. This forms a 12-petal flower with one lp in each petal. Make 73 Daisies.

**BLOCK**—In color, sc in one petal, \* (ch 7, sc in next petal) 3 times, ch 9, sl st in last sc to form a p. Repeat from \* 3 times. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat as far as 2d corner. In place of corner 9-ch p, ch 4, sl st in 1 lp of center st of a corner p on 1st Block, ch 4, sl st back in last sc to complete joining p. \* Ch 3, sl st in next 7-ch lp on 1st Block, ch 3, sc back in next petal on 2d Block.

Repeat from \* twice. Then join corner ps as at last corner, complete Block and fasten off as before.

**CENTER**—Join 9 Blocks into a square (3 on each side).

**BORDER ROW 1**—Sc in White in p at one corner of square, \* (ch 7, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 7, sc between ps at joining of Blocks. Repeat from \* to next corner. In corner p, make (sc, ch 9, sc). Repeat from \* around, ending with corner 9-ch lp. **ROW 2**—Sl st to center st of next lp. Cut a card  $2\frac{3}{8}$ " long. Draw out lp on hook to the length of card, thread over and pull thru lp, \* ch 7, yarn over, insert hook in 1 lp of center st of next 7-ch lp, catch yarn, pull thru and up to length of card, (yarn over and thru 2 lps on hook) twice (a long dc completed). Repeat from \* around. At corners, make (ch 7, a long dc) 8 times in corner lp. Repeat from \* around, ch 7. sc in 1st long dc and fasten off.

**DAISY ROW**—Join a Block by one corner p to center 7-ch lp at one corner of Scarf. Join a 2d Block to 1st Block and to the same corner 7-ch lp, and to the next 4 lps between long dc of last row. Continue to make and join Blocks around square (24 Blocks in row). Repeat Border Rows 1 and 2, then repeat Daisy Row (40 Daisies in row). Repeat Border Row 1 again. **Edge**—Join White to a 9-ch corner lp, ch 9, dtr in same lp, (ch 2, dtr) 4 times in same corner lp, \* dtr in 1 lp of center st of next 7-ch lp, (ch 2, dtr in same st) twice. Repeat from \* to next corner lp, (ch 2, dtr) 5 times in same lp. Repeat from \* around and join to 7th st of 1st 9-ch. Fasten off. Join color between 1st 2 dtr at one corner, \* (ch 5, sl st in 1 lp of 4th ch st from hook for a p, ch 2, sc between next 2 dtr) 4 times around corner shell, (ch 2, sk 2 dtr, sc in next 2-ch sp, ch 5, p, ch 2, sc in next sp) repeated across to corner shell. Repeat from \* around and fasten off.

Stretch and pin Scarf right-side-down in a true 30-inch square. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

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5 for a tr, (a 3-p lp, tr in next shell) repeated around and join. Fasten off. Repeat on other Sleeve.

Block Jacket to desired size. Run ribbon thru beading row around neck and sleeves.

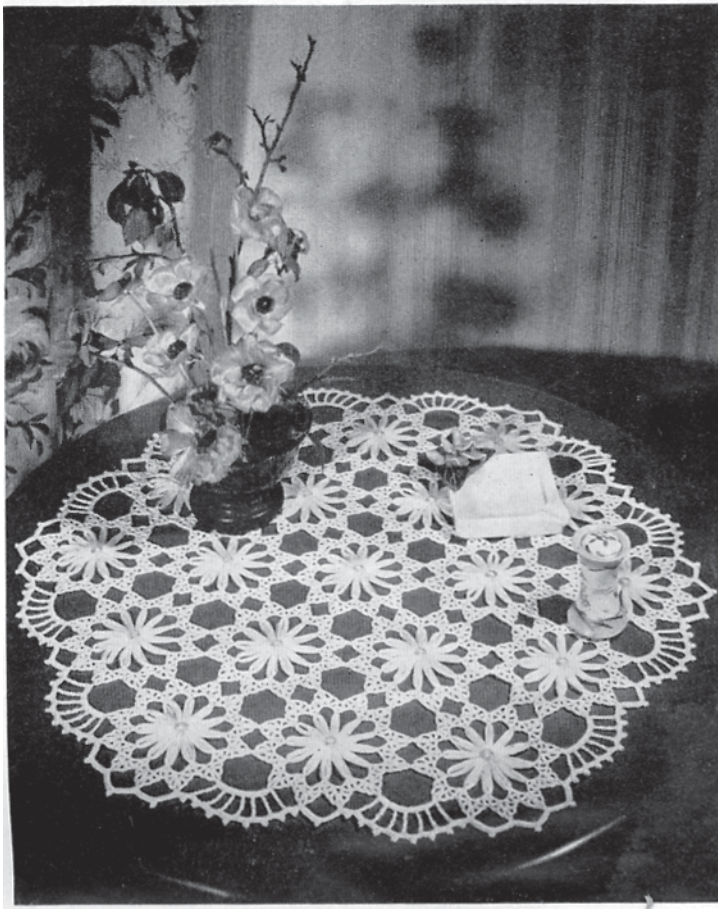
**BOOTEES—Sole**—In colored yarn, ch 22, 3 hdc in 4th st, 9 hdc and 8 sc on ch, 3 sc in end st. On other side of ch make 8 sc and 9 hdc, 3 hdc in next st, sl st in 3-ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, 2 dc in same st, 3 dc in next st, (2 dc in next) twice, dc in 16 sts, 2 dc in next st, (3 dc in next st) 3 times, 2 dc in next st, dc in 16 sts, (2 dc in next st) twice, 3 dc in next, sl st in 3-ch. **ROW 3**—Ch 3, (2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next) 4 times, dc in 18 dc, (2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next) 6 times, dc in 18 dc, (2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next) twice, 2 dc in next, sl st in 3-ch. **ROW 4**—Ch 1, (2 sc in next dc, 1 sc in next) 6 times, sc in 20 dc, (2 sc in next dc, 1 sc in next) 8 times, sc in 20 dc, (2 sc in next dc, 1 sc in next) 3 times and join. **ROW 5**—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in 1 lp of each sc around. **ROW 6**—1 sc thru both lps of each sc around. Fasten off.

**TOP**—Join 3 Blocks (as for Bonnet) into a straight band. **4th BLOCK**

—Sc in 1 petal, (ch 5, sc in next petal) 7 times, ch 3, sl st in p at bottom corner of band, ch 3, sl st back in last sc, (ch 2, sl st in next 5-ch lp up end of band, ch 2, sc back in next petal) twice, ch 5, sc in next petal, ch 2, sl st in center lp on other end of band, ch 2, sc back in next petal, ch 2, sl st in next lp on band, ch 2, sl st back in 1st sc, ch 3, sl st in corner p on bottom of band, ch 3, sl st back in same sc. (5 sc in next lp) 7 times around 4th Block (toe). \* 2 sc in next p, 1 sc between ps, 2 sc in next p, \*\* (4 sc in next lp) 3 times. Repeat from \* twice and from \* to \*\*. Join and fasten off. Sew to Sole going thru only 1 lp of each st.

**Top Edge**—Sc in single free lp at top of toe Daisy, ch 3, dc in next 5-ch lp on next Daisy, ch 3, sc in corner p, ch 5, tr in same p, \* (ch 2, 2 tr in next lp) 3 times, ch 2, \*\* 2 tr between next 2 ps. Repeat from \* once and from \* to \*\*. 1 tr in next p, ch 5, sc in same p, ch 3, dc in next lp, ch 3, sl st in starting sc. **ROW 2**—(3 sc in next sp) twice, 5 sc in next lp, 1 sc in tr, \* (2 sc, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p and 1 sc) all in next sp, sc in 2 tr. Repeat from \* around top. 1 sc in end tr, 5 sc in next lp, (3 sc in next sp) twice, join and fasten off. Run narrow ribbon thru top beading row. Make a 2d Bootee.





## No. 17 DOILY "Daisy Stars"

**MATERIALS**—Lily SKYSTONE Mercerized Crochet Cotton:—2-balls Cream; Lily Six Strand Floss:—2-sks. Orange. Crochet hook size 10. CRAZY DAISY WINDER. Size—18½" x 19½".

**BLOCK**—(Size—3¾")—**Daisy**—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind Cream 6 times around each spoke of Winder, cut 1" long and weave center as in Ill. E, using Orange Floss,—making a 12-petal flower with 6 lps in each petal. **Edge**—In Cream, sc thru all 6 lps of one petal, (ch 9, sc in next petal) 11 times, ch 9, sl st in 1st sc, ch 1, sc in next lp. **ROW 2**—\*(Ch 5, sc) 3 times in same lp, ch 2, sc in next lp. Repeat from \* around. End with ch 2, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 3**—Ch 1, sc in next 5-ch lp, \* ch 2, dc in next lp, (ch 3, dc) 3 times in same lp, ch 2, sc in next lp, ch 1, sk 2-ch in angle, sc in next 5-ch lp. Repeat from \* around. End with ch 1, sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat to \* in Row 3. \*\*Ch 2, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next lp, ch 1, sl st in a point on 1st Block, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) back in same lp on 2d Block, ch 2, sc in next lp, ch 1, sk 2-ch in angle, sc in next 5-ch lp. Repeat from \*\* to join next point to next point on 1st Block. Complete 2d Block as for 1st Block.

**3d BLOCK**—Join by 2 points to the next 2 points on 1st Block and by the next 2 points to 2 points on 2d Block. Continue to make and join Blocks. Join 6 in a circle around 1st (center) Block. Then make a 2d row around of 12 Blocks.

**EDGE**—Each corner Block has 6 free points around outside. With wrong-side-up, join Cream to 6th point, ch 15, sc in 1st free point on next Block. Ch 1, turn, 18 sc and 1 sl st in lp, ch 8, tr in next point on corner Block. \* Ch 4, turn, tr in 3d sc on added lp between Blocks, (ch 4, tr in next 3d sc) 5 times, ch 4, sc in next point on next Block, \* ch 12, sc in next point. Ch 1, turn, (7 sc, ch 4, sl st in last sc for a p, and 7 sc) all in 12-ch lp, (3 sc, a p and 2 sc) in each of eight 4-ch sps. Fasten off. Turn and join to 4th point on

Block to right of same corner Block, ch 15, sc in 1st point on corner Block. Ch 1, turn, 18 sc and 1 sl st in lp, ch 8, tr in next point. Repeat from \* to \*. (Ch 12, sc in next point) 3 times. Ch 1, turn, (7 sc, p, 7 sc) in each 12-ch lp, (3 sc, a p and 2 sc) in each 4-ch sp. Fasten off. Repeat from beginning of EDGE 6 times around Doily.

Stretch and pin right-side-down in a true circle. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

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on 1st Block, ch 2, sc back in next petal, ch 1, sl st in next 3-ch lp on 1st Block, ch 1, 2 dc back in next petal, ch 3, sl st thru 1 lp of the center st of next corner 7-ch on 1st Block, ch 3, 2 dc back in same petal and complete Block as for 1st one. Continue to join Blocks in same way.

**CAP**—Circle—Sc in Pearl Cotton thru both lps of one petal of a Daisy, (ch 5, sc in next petal) 11 times, ch 5, sl st in 1st sc, sc in next lp. **ROW 2**—(Ch 4, sc in same lp, ch 4, sc in next lp) repeated around, ending with ch 2, dc in 1st sc. **ROW 3**—(Ch 5, sc in next lp) repeated around. Fasten off. **ROW 4**—Sl st in Baby Yarn in one lp, ch 3, 2 dc in same lp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next lp) repeated around. Ch 1, sl st in 1st 3-ch. Fasten off. **ROW 5**—Sl st in Pearl Cotton in a 1-ch sp, ch 3, 3 dc in same sp, (ch 1, 4 dc in next 1-ch sp) repeated around. Ch 1, sl st in 1st 3-ch. **ROW 6**—(Ch 6, sl st thru 1 lp of 4th ch st from hook for a p, ch 2, sc in next 1-ch sp) repeated around. Fasten off. Make a 2d Circle.

**Center Band**—Make and join 15 Blocks (3 x 5 rows) as in Chart. **Edge**—Working across one end, join Pearl Cotton to corner lp, ch 3, 2 dc in same lp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next lp) 13 times, ch 1, (2 dc, ch 3 and 1 sc) all in corner lp, \* (ch 1, sc in next lp) repeated to next corner, ch 1, sc in same corner lp. Repeat from \* twice. Repeat Row 6 of Circle across end (Front). Fasten off. Across other end, sc in corner 1-ch sp, (ch 3, sc in next 1-ch sp) repeated across. Fasten off. Sew one side of Band under edge of half of one Circle. Sew other side to other Circle. Block to desired size.

**Tie**—Cut a 27" piece of ribbon, make a 4-lp bow on one end and tack to bottom edge of one Circle. Repeat on other side.

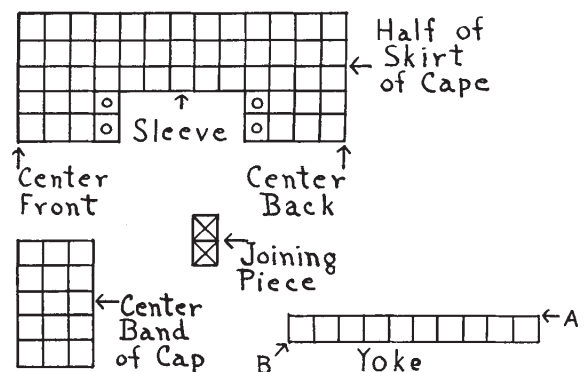
**CAPE**—Make and join 10 Blocks into a straight row for Yoke (see Chart). Join Pearl Cotton to A-Corner lp, ch 7, tr in next 3-ch sp, (ch 2, tr in next sp) repeated around top of Yoke to next corner. Fasten off. Join to B-Corner on Chart, ch 3, 3 dc in same corner lp, (ch 1, 4 dc in next lp) repeated around bottom of Yoke to next corner. Fasten off.

Make and join 110 Blocks for Skirt (see Chart), leaving center front open. Make 2 ☒-Blocks, joining to each other and to [o]-Blocks on Front and Back, leaving 5 Blocks on bottom of Sleeve section free. Repeat on other side of Cape.

**Top Edge**—Join Pearl Cotton to top corner of Right Front, ch 2, sc in same corner lp, \* ch 2, sc in next 2d (center) sp, ch 2, sc in corner lp of same Block, ch 2, sc in corner lp of next Block. Repeat from \* across top edge to next corner, making ch 2, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner lp. Fasten off. Sew this edge under bottom edge of Yoke.

**Edge**—Sc in Pearl Cotton in A-Corner of Yoke, ch 4, sc in same corner lp, (ch 4, sc in next 2-ch sp) repeated around neck. Ch 3, 2 dc in same corner lp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next sp) repeated down front, around bottom and up other front, putting (ch 1, 3 dc) twice in

# Daisy Centerpiece

**MATERIALS**—DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton size 30 (400-yd. balls): — 2-balls White, Cream or Ecu. Crochet hook size 13. CRAZY DAISY WINDER. Size—21".

**LARGE MOTIF** — (Size—4¾")—Daisy—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind 6 times around spokes 1 and 2 of Winder, twice around spokes 3 and 4, twice around spokes 5 and 6, 6 times around spokes 7 and 8, twice around spokes 9 and 10 and twice around spokes 11 and 12. Cut 20" long and weave center as in Ill. E, making 37 sts around (3 rows). **Edge**—Sc in all 6 lps of one 6-lp petal, \* (ch 9, dc in 2d ch st from sc, ch 2, sc in one lp of next petal, ch 9, dc in 2d ch st from sc, ch 2, sc in 2d lp of same petal) twice, ch 9, dc in 2d ch st from sc, ch 2, sc thru all 6 lps of next petal. Repeat from \* 3 times, ending with a sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—Sl st to center st of next lp, ch 6, dc in same st, \* ch 5, (dc, ch 3, dc) in one lp of center st of next lp. Repeat from \* around. End with ch 5, sl st in 3d st of 1st 6-ch. **ROW 3**—Ch 5, (2 tr, ch 2, 1 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) all in next 3-ch sp, \* (3 tr, ch 2, 1 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) all in next 3-ch shell. Repeat from \* around. Sl st in top of 1st 5-ch. **ROW 4**—Sl st to next 2-ch sp, ch 5, 3 tr in same sp, \*\* (ch 7, 4 tr in next sp, 4 tr in 1st 2-ch sp of next shell) repeated around. Sl st in 1st 5-ch. \* Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

Make 10 Motifs and join into a border circle as follows:—**2d MOTIF**—Repeat to \*\* in Row 4. Ch 3, sl st in final shell on 1st Motif, ch 3, 4 tr back in next 2-ch sp on 2d Motif, 4 tr in 1st 2-ch sp on next shell, ch 3, sl st in next shell on 1st Motif, ch 3, 4 tr back in next 2-ch sp on 2d Motif and complete as for 1st Motif. Join remaining 8 Motifs in same way, leaving 10 shells free between joinings around outside of each Motif and 6 on inside of circle. Be careful to join so that a heavy 6-lp petal in center of each Motif points directly towards center of doily.

**SMALL MOTIF**—Daisy—Wind 3 times around each spoke of Winder. Cut 16" long and weave center, making 25 sts around (2 rows). **Edge**—Going thru all 3 lps of each petal, make 11 sc in the end of each petal. Sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, 3 dc in one lp of center sc of next petal, ch 2, sl st in 3d shell from joining of 2 Large Motifs (on inside of circle), ch 2, 3 dc back in same sc, ch 3, sc between petals, \* ch 3, 3 dc in center sc of next petal, ch 2, sl st in next shell on Large Motif (2d shell from joining of Motifs), ch 2, 3 dc back in same sc, ch 3, sc between petals, \* ch 3, 3 dc in center sc of next petal, ch 10, sl st in next shell on Large Motif, ch 7, sl st across in



1st shell on next Large Motif, ch 7, sk last 7 sts of 10-ch, sl st in next st, ch 2, 3 dc back in same sc on Small Motif, ch 3, sc between petals. Repeat from \* to \* twice, joining to next 2 shells on Large Motif. Then \*\* ch 3, (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) all in center st of next petal, ch 3, sc between petals. Repeat from \*\* 6 times. Cut 6" long and fasten off on back. Make another Small Motif, joining to Large Motifs in same way and by 2 petals to the last 2 petals on 1st Small Motif. Make and join 8 more Small Motifs in same way into a circle inside the circle of Large Motifs, leaving 3 petals free on each Small Motif around inside of circle.

**CENTER**—Repeat Large Motif to \* in Row 4. **ROW 5**—Sl st to next 7-ch, ch 5, (4 tr, ch 7, 5 tr) all in same 7-ch lp, (5 tr, ch 7 and 5 tr,—all in next shell) repeated around. Sl st in 1st 5-ch. **ROW 6**—Sl st to next 7-ch lp, ch 5, 5 tr in same lp, ch 3, sl st in center petal on one Small Motif, \* ch 3, 6 tr back in same shell on Center, 6 tr in next shell on Center, ch 9, sl st in next petal on same Small Motif, ch 10, sl st in 1st petal on next Small Motif, ch 6, sk last 6 sts of 9-ch, sl st in next ch st, ch 2, 6 tr back in same shell on Center, 6 tr in next shell on Center, ch 3, sl st in next petal on same Small Motif. Repeat from \* around. Fasten off.

**EDGE**—Join to 1st free shell on outside of one Large Motif, ch 6 for a tr, \* (ch 16, tr in center st of next shell) 9 times, ch 2, tr in 1st shell on next Motif. Repeat from \* around. End with 2-ch, sl st in 6th st of 1st lp. **ROW 2**—\* (10 sc in half of next lp, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p, 10 sc in bal. of lp) 9 times, 1 sc in 2-ch in angle. Repeat from \* around. Fasten off.

Stretch and pin right-side-down in a true circle, pinning down each lp of Edge. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

each bottom corner. Ch 3, sl st in 1st sc. Fasten off. Join to neck corner of Left Front and repeat Row 6 of Edge on Cap Circle on both Fronts and around bottom, putting an extra p-lp at each bottom corner. Repeat these last 2 rows around edge of each Sleeve and across top of Joining Pieces under arms. Block Cape to desired size. Run 1-yd. of ribbon thru beading around neck. Fasten bottom corners of Yoke with a pearl button.

**CARRIAGE ROBE**—Make and join 216 Blocks (12 x 18 rows). **Edge**—Join Pearl Cotton in one corner, ch 4, sc in same corner lp, (ch 4,

sc in next lp) repeated around, putting 3 lps in each corner. **ROW 2**—Sl st in 1st lp, (ch 4, sc in next lp) repeated around, with an extra lp at each corner. Fasten off. **ROW 3**—Join Baby Yarn in one corner, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same lp, (ch 2, 3 dc in next lp) repeated around with (ch 2, 3 dc) twice in each corner. Join and fasten off. **ROW 4**—Repeat last row in Pearl Cotton except make 1-chs instead of 2-chs. **ROW 5**—Repeat Row 6 of Edge on Cap Circle, making an extra p-lp in each corner. Fasten off.

Stretch and pin Robe right-side-down on a large, padded table or board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

# Daisy Beret and Bag

## "CLIMAX TO SMARTNESS"

**MATERIALS**—Jack Frost Knitting Worsted (4-fold Germantown) in 4-oz. Skeins:—1-sk. Harding Blue and 1½-sks. Silver Gray. Crochet hook size 0. CRAZY DAISY WINDER. Buckram and 2/5 yd. Gray felt for lining Bag.

**DAISY**—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind Blue yarn twice around each spoke of Winder. Cut 1" long and weave center with Gray as in Ill. E, making a 12-petal flower with 2 lps in each petal. Make 31 for Beret and 30 for Bag.

**BLOCK**—In Gray, sc thru both lps of one petal, \* ch 2, sc in back lp of next petal, sc in front lp, ch 2, \*\* (sc, ch 3, sc) in both lps of next petal. Repeat from \* around. End with 1 sc in 1st petal, ch 3, sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat to \*. Ch 2, sc in each lp of next petal, ch 2, sc in both lps of next petal, ch 1, sl st in a corner p of 1st Block, \*\* ch 1, sc back in same petal, ch 1, sl st in next 2-ch sp on 1st Block, ch 1, sc back in each lp of next petal, ch 1, sl st in next 2-ch sp on 1st Block, ch 1, sc back in both lps of next petal, ch 1, \* sl st in corner p of 1st Block, ch 1, sc back in same petal. Complete Block as for 1st one.

**3d BLOCK**—Repeat 1st Block to \*\*. Sc in both lps of next petal, ch 1, sl st in 1st corner

p to left of joining of 1st 2 Blocks and repeat 2d Block from \*\* to \*. Sl st in joining of 1st 2 Blocks and repeat 2d Block from \*\* to end.

**BERET**—Following Chart, make and join 19 Blocks for Top. **Edge**—Sl st in Gray in corner A on Chart, 1 hdc and 1 dc in next 2-ch sp, \* 1 tr in next 2d sc, 1 tr in next 2-ch sp, dtr in corner p, dtr in joining of Blocks, dtr in next p, tr in next 2-ch sp, tr in next 2d sc, \*\* 2 tr in next sp, 2 dc in corner p, 2 tr in next sp. \*\*\*Repeat from \* to \*\*. 1 dc and 1 hdc in next sp, sl st in corner sp. Fasten off. Fill out remaining 5 sides in same way, but do not cut after final side. **ROW 2**—\* Continue with sc in corner p, (2 sc in next sp) twice, sc in corner p, 1 sc in each st to next corner p. Repeat from \* around. **ROW 3**—1 sc in each sc around. Fasten off.

**Under Side**—Sc in Gray thru both lps of one petal of a Daisy, \* (ch 2, 1 sc in each lp of next petal, ch 2, 2 sc thru both lps of next petal) repeated around. End with 2-ch, 1 sc in 1st petal, sl st in 1st sc and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat to \*. Ch 1, sl st in a 2-ch sp on 1st Daisy, ch 1, 1 sc back in each lp of next petal, ch 1, sl st in next sp on 1st Daisy, ch 1, 2 sc back thru both lps of next petal and complete as for 1st Daisy. Join 10 more Daisies in same way into a circle, having 4 free petals between joinings on each Daisy on inside of circle and 6 on outside.

**Outside Edge**—Sl st in Gray in joining between Daisies, ch 7, \* tr in next 1-ch sp, 2 dc in next 2-ch sp, 2 sc in next sp, (ch 1, 2 sc in next sp) twice, 2 dc in next sp, 1 tr in next, dtr in joining of Daisies. Repeat from \* around and join. **ROW 2**—1 sc in each st and 1-ch sp around. **ROW 3**—1 sc in each sc around. Fasten off.

**Inside Edge**—Sl st in 1st 1-ch sp on one Daisy (next joining of Daisies), ch 6, \* dc in next 2d sc, 2 dc in next sp, 2 sc in next, 2 dc in next, 1 dc in next 2d sc, tr in next 1-ch sp, tr in next 1-ch sp on next Daisy. Repeat from \* around and join. **ROW 2**—(1 sc in each st around) repeated for 5 rows. Fasten off. **ROW 7**—Sl st in Blue in 1 sc,

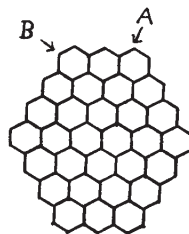


Chart for Handbag

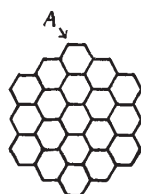


Chart for Beret

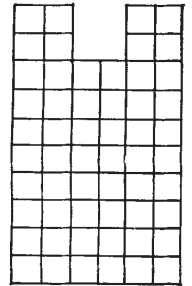

## "DICKEY 'DORABLE"

**MATERIALS**—Jack Frost Baby Wool (1-oz. balls):—1-ball White. Lily Sil-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton (100-yd. balls):—3-balls White. Crochet hook size 13. 1½-yds. narrow ribbon. Net or cloth for back. 2-crystal buttons for Bows and 1 small pearl button. CRAZY DAISY WINDER.

**BLOCK—Daisy**—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind wool yarn twice around each spoke of Winder. Cut 14" long and weave center as in Ill. E, making a 12-petal flower with 2 lps in each petal. Make 56. **Edge**—Sc in Sil-Tone thru both lps of one petal, \* ch 5, 2 dc in starting st of 5-ch, holding back the last lp of each dc on hook, thread over and pull thru all 3 lps on hook at once for a Cluster, ch 1, (sc, ch 4, sc) in next petal. Repeat from \* once. Ch 5, a Cluster in 1st st, ch 1, 1 sc in next petal, ch 8, sl st in starting st of 8-ch, \*\* ch 9, (sl st, ch 7, sl st) in same st, sc in same petal. Repeat from \* around. End with sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat to \*\*. Ch 4, sl st in 1 lp of center st of a corner p on 1st Block, ch 4, sl st back in same st on 2d Block, ch 3, sl st in next p on 1st Block, ch 3, sl st back in same st on 2d Block, sc in same petal, (ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, sc in next petal, ch 2, sl st in next p on 1st Block, ch 2, sc back in same petal) twice, ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, sc in next petal, ch 4, sl st in next p on 1st Block, ch 3, sk last 3 sts of 4-ch, sl st back in next ch st, ch 4, sl st in center st of next p on 1st Block, ch 4, (sl st, ch 7, sl st) back in same st on 2d Block, sc in same petal and complete Block. Continue to make and join Blocks as in Chart.

**NECK FILL-INS**—Join to p between. 1st 2 Clusters to left of center of neck, ch 8, a 2-dc-Cluster in 5th ch st from hook, a 2-dc-Cluster in next p, ch 5, a 2-dc-Cluster in 1st st of 5-ch, ch 1, a 2-dc-Cluster in next p, a Cluster in corner joining of Blocks, a Cluster in next free p, ch 5, a Cluster in 1st st, ch 1, a Cluster in next p, ch 5, a Cluster in 1st st, dc in next p. Ch 8, a Cluster in 5th st from hook, ch 1, turn, a 2-tr-Cluster

# Midwinter Daisies

**MATERIALS**—Jack Frost Knitting Worsted (4-fold Germantown) in 4-oz. skeins:—2-sks. White and 1-sk. Variegated. Crochet hook size 0. **CRAZY DAISY WINDER.**

**BLOCK—Daisy**—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind white twice around each spoke of Winder, cut about 14" long and weave center as in Ill. E, making a 12-petal flower with 2 lps in each petal.

**Edge**—In White, sc thru 2 lps of one petal, (ch 3, sc thru both lps of next petal) 11 times, ch 3, sl st in 1st sc, cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Make a 2d Daisy. Sc in one petal, ch 1, sl st in a 3-ch lp on 1st Block, ch 1, sc back in next petal on 2d Daisy, ch 1, sl st in next 3-ch lp on 1st Block, ch 1, sc back in next petal on 2d Daisy, (ch 3, sc in next petal) 9 times, ch 3, sl st in 1st sc and fasten off.

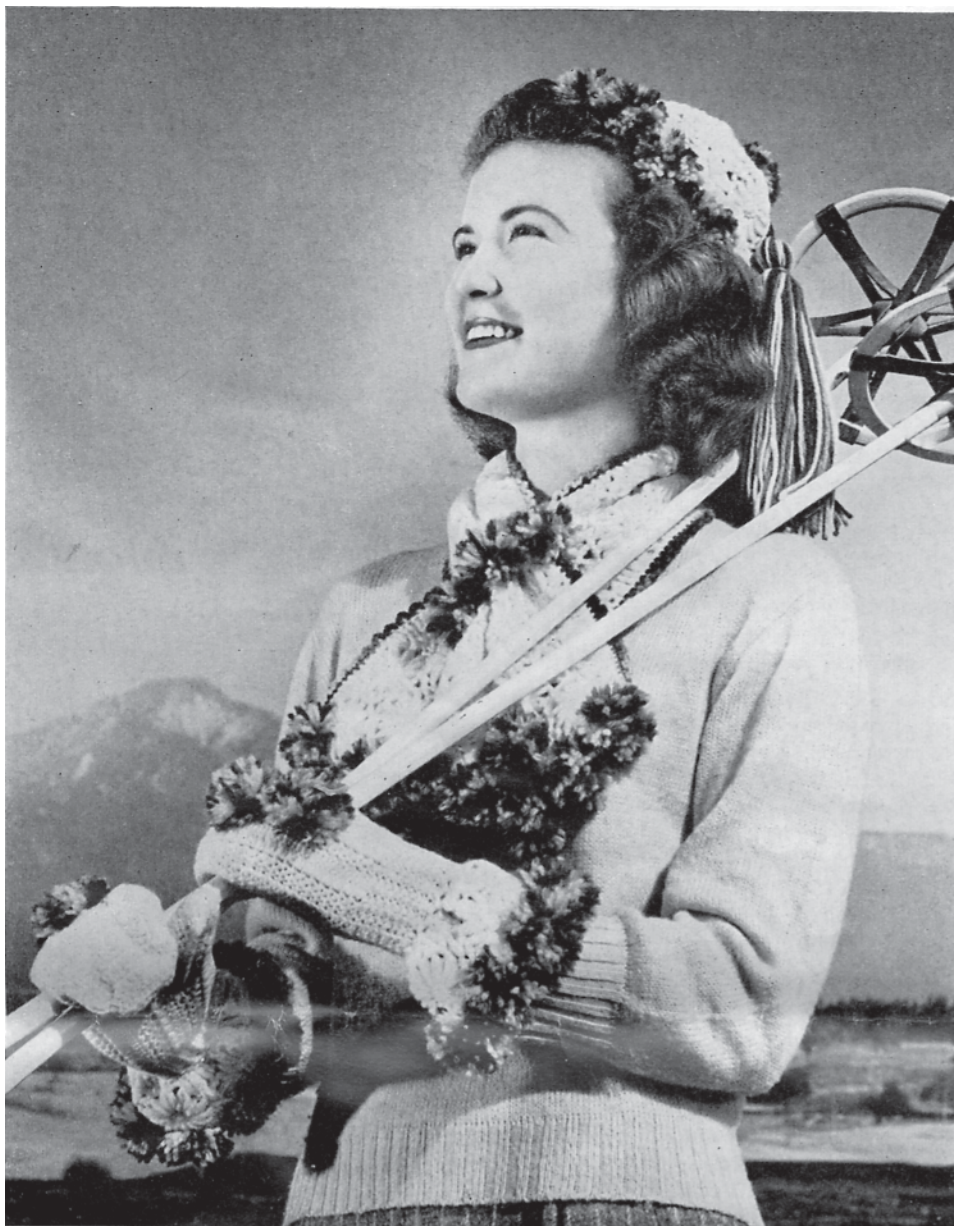
**CAP**—Make 24 Daisies. Join 8 Blocks by 2 lps on each side of each, into a straight row, and join the ends. Make another Block and place it between 2 Blocks in 1st row, joining it to 2 lps on one Block and to the next 2 lps on adjoining Block in 1st row. Make another Block and join to last Block, to the next 2 lps on same Block in 1st row and to the next 2 lps on next adjoining Block in 1st row. Continue to make and join 6 more Blocks around to complete 2d row. Then make and join a 3d row around, between the Blocks in last row.

**Bottom Edge**—In White make 3 sc in each of 2 center lps on one Block, \* (1 dc and 1 tr) in next lp, 1 dtr in next half-lp, 1 dtr in half-lp on next Block, (1 tr and 1 dc) in next lp, (3 sc in next lp) twice. Repeat from \* around, join and fasten off. **ROW 2**—In Variegated, make 1 sc in each st around. Repeat for Row 3 and fasten off.

Steam and press dry on wrong side thru a cloth. Run a thread thru each Block around top edge and gather tightly.

**POM PON**—Make a Daisy in Variegated, winding 4 times around each spoke, cut 16" long and weave center. Cut all 4 lps in each petal and rub in hands to fluff into a pom pon. Make 12 and tack around bottom edge. Make 3 more, tack tog. into a large pom pon and sew over top gathers.

**TASSEL**—Wind Variegated 40 times around a 10½" card. Cut at one edge. Tie a 14" strand tightly around center, fold strands in center, thread one end of tie strand to a needle, run it down thru tassel, wind it tightly around tassel 1" from top and fasten.



In Variegated, ch 35 and join into a lp. With other end of tie strand, fasten tassel to center of ch-lp. Tack other end of lp to top under pom pon.

**SCARF**—Make 46 Daisies. Join 16 Blocks into a straight row. On each side of this row, join a row of 15 Blocks in same way as for Cap.

**Edge**—On sides of Band, in White, make 2 sc in each of 2 center sps on one Block, \* (1 dc and 1 tr) in next sp, 1 dtr in next half-sp, 1 dtr in half-sp on next Block, (1 tr and 1 dc) in next sp, (2 sc in next sp) twice. Repeat from \* across to corner. Around each of the 3 Blocks on end, make (3 sc in next sp) 4 times, filling in between Blocks the same as on sides. Complete row and fasten off. **ROW 2**—Join Variegated and make 1 sc in each st. **ROW 3**—(Ch 3, sl st in next 2 sc) repeated around and fasten off. Make 6 Pom Pons and tack 5 around one end of Band with 6th Pom above center one. Repeat on other end.

**Strap**—In Variegated, ch 23, 22 sc on ch.

(Ch 1, turn, 22 sc) 3 times. Fasten off. With Strap lengthwise of Band, tack one end to center of Band 7" from one end. Leave Strap slightly loose and tack other end. Make 3 Pom Pons and tack on Strap. Cross Scarf, passing other end under Strap.

**RIGHT MITTEN—Back**—In White, ch 60, sc in 2d st, (ch 1, sc in next 2d st) repeated to end. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, turn, sc in last sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 21 times, (ch 1, sc in back lp of next sc) 8 times (to form ribbed wrist). **ROW 3**—Ch 1, turn and in back lps, sc in last sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 7 times, \* (ch 1, sc in both lps of next sc) 22 times. **ROW 4**—Ch 2, turn, dc in last sc, (2 dc in next sc) 21 times. In back lps, sc in next sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 7 times. **ROW 5**—Repeat Row 3 to \*. (Ch 1, sc in both lps of next 2d dc) 22 times. Repeat Rows 2, 3, 4 and 5 twice and Rows 2 and 3 again. **End**—Working across end of rows, ch 3, \* (dc in 2 rows) holding back the last lp of each dc on hook, yarn over and pull thru all 3 lps at once for a Cluster, 1 dc in next

# Daisies for Sport

**MATERIALS**—Jack Frost Knitting Worsted (4-fold Germantown) in 4-oz. skeins:—6-sks. Red and ½-sk. Variegated Rainbow. Crochet hook size 0. 1-pr. shoulder pads. 1-button. Size 34 to 38. **CRAZY DAISY WINDER.**

**DAISY**—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind Red yarn twice around each spoke of Winder. Cut about 14" long and weave center as in Ill. E, making a 12-petal flower with 2 lps in each petal. Make 164 Daisies for Sweater and 18 for Hood.

**BLOCK**—Sc in Red thru 2 lps of one petal, \* ch 4, dc in 4th ch st from hook, \*\* ch 3, sl st in same st, sc in same petal, ch 5, hdc in 4th ch st from hook for a p, sc thru 2 lps of next petal, ch 4, hdc in 4th ch st from hook, sc in next petal, ch 4, hdc in 4th ch st from hook, ch 1, sc in next petal. Repeat from \* 3 times ending with a sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat to \*\*. Sl st in 1 lp of dc in a corner shell on 1st Block, ch 3, sl st back in st where dc was made, sc in same petal, ch 3, sl st in next p on 1st Block, ch 1, hdc back in center st of 3-ch, sc in next petal, \* ch 2, sl st in next p on 1st Block, ch 1, hdc back in starting st of 2-ch, \* sc in next petal. Repeat from \* to \*. Ch 1, sc in next petal, ch 4, dc in 4th ch st from hook, sl st in 1 lp of dc in next corner shell on 1st Block, ch 3, sl st back in st where dc was made, sc in same petal. Complete Block as for 1st one. Continue to make and join Daisies as in Chart.

**POM PON DAISIES** — Wind Variegated Yarn 4 times around each spoke, cut 1" long and weave center with Red yarn. Make 29 of these for Sweater and 6 for Hood. Work around and join them with Red yarn in same way, except go thru only the 2 back lps of each petal, leaving the 2 top lps of each petal free.

Following Chart, join 38 Red Blocks and 4 Variegated Blocks for each Sleeve, joining



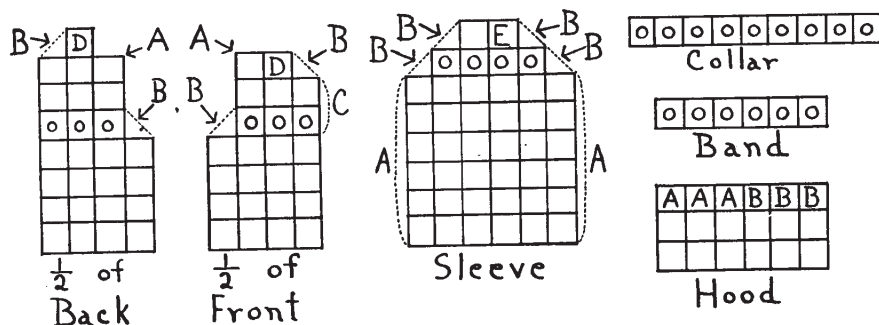
ends of 6 rows marked A. Join 46 Red Blocks and 6 Variegated Blocks for Back. Join 42 Red Blocks and 6 Variegated Blocks for Front, joining the 4-Block row on each side of Front to corresponding row on each side of Back. At top of center Front, do not join the 2 Blocks marked C to corresponding Blocks on other side of Front. At shoulders, join Blocks marked D. Join Red to corner shell marked A on Back, ch 3, sl st in corner shell marked A on Front, ch 1, hdc back in same shell on Back, forming a triangular opening on shoulder. To fill in, ch 3, dc under hdc, (ch 1, 2 dc in next

p on shoulder of Back) 3 times, tr in joining of Blocks, 2 dc in next p on side of Block D on Back, (ch 1, 2 dc in next p) twice, tr in joining of Blocks, 2 dc in next p, (ch 1, 2 dc in next p) twice, sl st in 1st dc. Ch 3, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 1-ch sp, ch 1, dc in next 1-ch sp, sk 4 dc, dc in next 1-ch sp, dc in next 1-ch sp, sk 4 dc, dc in next 1-ch sp, ch 1, dc in next 1-ch sp, sl st in 1st 3-ch. Fasten off. Repeat on other shoulder.

To fill in all half-squares marked B on Chart, join Red to middle p up right-hand-side of a half-square, ch 1, dc in next p, 3 tr in joining of Blocks, dc in next p, ch 1, sc in next (center) p, ch 2, dc in next p, ch 2, turn, dc in 3 center tr, ch 2, dc in same p where work started, ch 3, sc in next p. Fasten off.

To round top of Sleeve, make sc in center p at top of Block E, ch 2, 2 dc in next p, ch 2, 3 dc in joining of Blocks, ch 2, 2 dc in next p, ch 2, sc in next p. Fasten off.

**ARMHOLE**—Join Red at 3-ch shoulder joining marked A, ch 3, 2 dc in same place,





ch 2, dc in side of corner shell, \* (ch 2, sc in next p) 3 times, ch 1, dc in side of corner shell, ch 1, dc in joining of Blocks, ch 1, dc in side of corner shell, ch 1, sc in next p, (ch 2, sc in next p) twice, ch 2, hdc in side of corner shell, \* ch 2, dc in joining of Blocks, ch 2, dc in next sc, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next 3 dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 3, dc in next p, ch 3, sc in joining of Blocks, ch 3, dc in next sc, ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next 3 dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next p, ch 2, dc in joining of Blocks, ch 2, hdc in side of corner shell. Repeat from \* to \*. Ch 2, sl st in 1st 3-ch. **ROW 2**—Work sc around, putting 1 sc in each 1-ch sp, 2 sc in 2-ch sps, 3 sc in 3-ch sps, and 1 sc in each st between chs. Join and fasten off. Repeat on other armhole.

**SLEEVE**—For armhole edge, join Red to underarm joining of Blocks, ch 2, dc in side of corner shell, \* ch 2, 2 dc in next sc, ch 1, 3 dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc in next dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next p, ch 2, sc in corner shell. \* Repeat from \* to \*. Ch 2, 2 dc in next p, ch 1, 2 tr in next sc, ch 1, (2 dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, dc in next 3 dc, ch 2, (2 dc in next dc) twice, ch 1, 2 tr in next sc, ch 1, 2 dc in next p, ch 2, sc in corner shell. Repeat from \* to \* twice. Repeat Row 2 of Armhole. Repeat on other Sleeve. Sew Sleeves into Armholes, going thru back lps of sts only. Make fullness at top of Sleeves into 2 pleats.

**NECK**—Sc in center-front corner shell, ch 4, tr in same place, ch 1, 2 tr in next sc, ch 1, 2 tr in next dc, ch 1, dc in next 3 dc, \* ch 1, 2 dc in next dc, ch 1, 2 dc in next p, ch 1, dc in side of corner shell, dc in joining of Blocks, dc in side of next corner shell, ch 1, 2 dc in next sc, ch 1, 2 dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next 3 dc. \*

Repeat from \* to \* twice. Ch 1, 2 tr in next dc, ch 1, 2 tr in next p, ch 1, 2 tr in corner shell. Ch 1, turn and work sc around, —1 sc in each 1-ch sp and 1 sc in each dc and tr. Fasten off.

**COLLAR** — Make and join 9 Pom Pon Blocks. **Edge**—Join to corner shell, ch 3, dc in same place, \* (ch 1, 2 dc in each of next 3 ps, ch 1, 2 dc in joining of Blocks) repeated across \* to other corner. Fasten off and sew to neck, going thru both lps of each st.

**BOTTOM BAND**—Sc in joining of 2 Blocks on one side, ch 3, dc in same place. Repeat from \* to \* on Collar around bottom edge. End with ch 1, sl st in 1st 3-ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, dc in next dc (ch 1, dc in next 6 dc, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc) repeated around and join. **Ribbing**—Ch 28, sc in 2d ch st from hook, (ch 1, sc in next 2d ch st) 13 times, \* insert hook under bar of next dc, bringing it up between this dc and the next one, yarn over and pull thru work and lp on hook for a sl st. Ch 1, turn, sk sl st, sc in back lp of last sc, (ch 1, sc in back lp of next sc) 13 times. Ch 1, turn, sc in back lp of last sc, (ch 1, sc in back lp of next sc) 13 times, a sl st under bar of next 2d dc, ch 1, turn, sc in back lp of last sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 13 times, ch 1, turn, sc in back lp of last sc, (ch 1, sc in back lp of next sc) 13 times. Repeat from \* around. Fasten off and sew 1st and last rows together.

**CUFF**—Repeat Rows 1 and 2 of Bottom Band. Repeat Ribbing except start with only 24 ch and make sl sts under bar of every 2d dc. Repeat on other sleeve.

Block Sweater to desired size and tack pads in shoulders.

**TIE**—Cut 3 strands Red 2-yds. long. Twist

tightly, double and twist in opposite direction. Fasten loose end. **Pom Pon**—Wind Variegated yarn 40 times around a 1" card. Cut at one edge. Tie an 8" strand tightly around center of strands, rub in hands to fluff and fasten to one end of Tie. Lace Tie across top slit on Front and tie at Collar. Make a 2d Pom Pon and fasten to other end of Tie.

**HOOD**—Make and join 18 Red Blocks as in Chart, folding piece crosswise in center and joining A Blocks to B Blocks. Turn top point forward and tack down.

**BAND**—Make and join 6 Pom Pon Blocks. Pin this over front row around Hood, exactly matching ps. Join Red to right corner, going thru corner shells on both pieces, ch 3, 4 dc in same place, \* (ch 1 and going thru both pieces, 2 dc in next p) 3 times, ch 3, 3 dc in joining of Blocks. Repeat from \* across to other corner. Put 5 dc in corner shell. Ch 1, (2 dc in each of next 3 ps, 3 dc in joining of Blocks) repeated around neck edge to corner. Ch 1, sl st in 1st 3-ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, dc in next dc, 5 dc in next dc, dc in each dc of last row with 1-ch over each 1-ch. Put 5 dc in opposite front corner. Sl st in 1st 3-ch, sl st to corner dc. **ROW 3**—1 sc in each dc and 1-ch sp around front to other corner. **Ribbed Band**—Ch 6, sc in 2d st, (ch 1, sc in next 2d ch st) twice, \* sl st under bar of next 2d dc (as for Ribbing on Sweater), \*\* ch 1, turn, sc in back lp of last sc, (ch 1, sc in back lp of next sc) twice, \*\* Ch 1, turn, sc in back lp of last sc, (ch 1, sc in back lp of next sc) twice. Repeat from \* around neck edge to other corner. **Strap**—Repeat from \*\* to \*\* for 5¼". Ch 10, turn, sl st in other end of last row. Fasten off. Sew button on left corner of Hood and fasten lp on Strap over it. Block Hood.

**COLLAR FRILL**—Join Pink wool at end of Edge on right Front and working around neck, make \* (4-ch, sc in back lp of next 4th sc) repeated around \* to Edge on Left Front, making 2-ch and dc in place of final 4-ch lp. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in next 4-ch lp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next lp) repeated around to 2d lp from end, 1 dc in end lp. **ROW 3**—Turn, (ch 4, sc in next 1-ch sp between dc-groups) repeated around, ch 1, sk end dc-group, dc in end 3-ch. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 twice and Row 2 again. Fasten off. **ROW 9**—Turn and join to start of Row 1, ch 3, dc in end of Row 2, \*\* (ch 2, dc in end of next row) 5 times, ch 2, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next sp, \* (ch 2 dc) twice in next 1-ch sp between dc-groups. Repeat from \* around, completing row across ends of previous rows as at start of row. Fasten off. **ROW 10**—Turn and join White at end of last row, \* (ch 5, sc in next sp) repeated around. Fasten off. **ROW 11**—Join Pink wool to 1st lp in last row, (ch 6, sc in next lp) repeated around and fasten off. **ROW 12**—Join White to same 1st lp in last White row, (ch 6, sc in next Pink lp) repeated

around to end White lp. Repeat Rows 11 and 12. **ROW 15**—Join Pink wool to 1st White lp in last row, draw out lp on hook to 1" length, yarn over and pull thru lp, insert hook between single back strand and 2 front strands of long lp, yarn over and pull thru, yarn over and pull thru 2 lps on hook, completing a Knot St. Make another Knot St, sc in next White lp, (2 Knot sts, sc in next lp) repeated around and fasten off. **ROW 16**—Join White to start of last row, ch 8, sc in center of 1st Knot St, (ch 6, sl st in 1 lp of 4th ch st from hook, ch 3, sc in center of next Knot St) repeated around. Ch 8, sc down in end White lp and fasten off.

**SLEEVE FRILL**—Make an inverted box pleat at bottom of each sleeve (see Chart). Join Pink wool at pleat and make sc around sleeve the same as around bottom of Jacket. Repeat Row 1 of Collar from \* to \*. Repeat Rows 2, 3 and 2. Turn, \* (ch 2, dc) twice in next 1-ch sp. Repeat from \* around, ch 3, sc in end 3-ch. Fasten off. Turn, join White at pleat and repeat last 7 rows of Collar beginning at \* in Row 10. Repeat Frill on other sleeve.

Block Jacket to desired size. Fasten Yoke with a dress snap. Tack an 18" piece of ribbon at base of collar on each side. Turn Sleeve Frill up at pleat and tack a ribbon bow on pleat.

Repeat from \* in Row 2 for 4th Row, join and fasten off.

**POM PON DAISY**— \* Wind once around each spoke with colored yarn. Drop but do not cut. Wind once around each spoke with White Baby Yarn and drop but do not cut. Repeat from \* twice. Cut colored yarn 1" long. Cut Baby Yarn 16" long and weave center with it, making a 12-petal flower with 3 colored lps and 3 white lps alternated in each petal. Cut each lp in all petals and rub in hands to fluff into a pom pon. Make 6 and starting at turned-down points, tack across top of Cap.

**ARMHOLE**—Join White yarn to corner of underarm Block marked C, \*\* ch 3, sc in next lp, ch 6, sk next Knot St, sc in next sc, sk 3 sc, sc in next sc, ch 6, sc in next lp at base of Knot St, ch 3, sc in corner lp of Block. \*\* Repeat from \*\* to \*\* once. Repeat from \* to \* in "Edge" 3 times. (Repeat from \*\* to \*\* once. Repeat from \* to \* in "Edge" once) twice. **ROW 2**—Make 3 sc in each 3-ch sp, 2 sc in each 2-ch sp, 6 sc in each 6-ch sp and 2 sc across center of each Half-Block. Fasten off.

**SLEEVE**—Join White to corner of Block D, ch 3, (dc, ch 3, tr) in next lp, ch 1, dtr in joining of Blocks, ch 1, (tr, ch 3, dc, ch 3, tr) all in next lp, ch 1, dtr in joining of Blocks, ch 1 (tr, ch 3, dc) in next lp, ch 3, sc in next corner lp. Repeat from \* to \* in "Edge" 4 times. Ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next lp, ch 3, sc in next corner lp. Repeat from \* to \* in "Edge" 4 times. Fasten off. Sew Sleeve into Armhole. Repeat with other Sleeve. **CUFF**—Join White to 1st sc in center of one Half-Block, \* sk 3 sc, sc in next sc, ch 6, sc in next lp at base of next Knot St, sc in corner lp of Block, sc in next lp, sc in next corner lp, sc in next lp, ch 6, sk Knot St, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* 4 times. **ROW 2**—\* 6 sc in next 6-ch lp, sc in next sc, (sc in next 2d sc) twice, 6 sc in next 6-ch lp. Repeat from \* around. Fasten off. Repeat Row 3 of "Edge". **ROW 4**—Sc in White in back lp of one Gold sc, ch 4, dc in same st, \* (dc, ch 1, dc) in back lp of next Gold sc. Repeat from \* around. Sl st in 3d st of 1st 4-ch. Fasten off. **ROW 5**—Sc in Gold in one 1-ch sp, (ch 2, sc in next 1-ch sp) repeated around. Fasten off. Repeat Rows 4 and 5. Repeat on other Sleeve.

**BELT**—In White yarn make a ch the desired length of belt, 3 sc in 2d st, 1 sc in each st across, 3 sc in end st, 1 sc in each st on other side of ch, sl st in 1st sc. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Sc in Gold in 1st of 5 sc at one end, \* (ch 2, sc in next sc) 4 times around end, (ch 2, sc in next 3d sc) repeated across. Repeat from \*. Fasten off. Repeat Rows 4 and 5 twice, widening as necessary around ends. Gather bottom of Sweater and sew under edge of Belt. Fasten Belt and Fronts with dress snaps. Block Sweater to desired size. Sew one button at collar and other on Belt.

**HAIR ORNAMENT—Pom Pon Daisies**—Wind White yarn 6 times around each spoke. Weave center in Gold thread making a 12-petal flower with 6 lps in each petal. **Edge**—Sc in Gold thread thru the back lp of one petal, \* (ch 3, sc in the next lp towards front of same petal) 5 times, ch 3, sc in back lp of next petal. Repeat from \* 11 times. Fasten off. Make 3. **Leaf**—In White yarn, ch 18, dc in 5th st from hook, \* ch 1, tr in next 2d ch st, (ch 2, dtr in next 2d st) 3 times, ch 1, tr in next 2d st, ch 1, dc in next 2d st, ch 1, \* (hdc, ch 3, hdc) in end st, ch 1, dc in next st on other side of ch. Repeat

from \* to \*. Sl st in 2d st of end 4-ch. Fasten off. Sc in Gold in same st, sc in next sp, (ch 2, 2 sc in next sp) 7 times, ch 2, (sc, ch 3, sc) in end sp, (ch 2, 2 sc in next sp) 8 times. Join and fasten off. Make 2. **Center Stem**—In White, ch 50, 49 sc on ch. Fasten off. In Gold, make 1 sl st in each ch st, then make 1 sl st in each sc back to end. Fasten off. **2d Stem**—Start with 25-ch and 24-sc. **3d Stem**—Start with 20-ch and 19-sc. Tack motifs into a group and fasten to a comb.

**BAG—Base**—In White yarn, ch 9, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in 1st 3-ch. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Sc in Gold in 1 dc, (ch 1, sc in next dc) repeated around. Fasten off. **ROW 3**—Sl st in White in back lp of 1 sc, ch 4, dc in same st, \* (dc, ch 1, dc,—all in back lp of next sc) repeated around. Sl st in 3d st of 1st 4-ch. Fasten off. **ROW 4**—Sc in Gold in one 1-ch sp, (ch 2, sc in next 1-ch sp) repeated around. Fasten off. **ROW 5**—Repeat Row 3 to \*. Ch 1, dc in same st, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc,—all in back lp of next Gold sc) repeated around. Sl st in 3d st of 1st 4-ch. Fasten off. **ROW 6**—Like Row 4 only make 1-ch between sc. Repeat Rows 3 and 4. **ROW 9**—Repeat Row 3 to \*. \* (Dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) all in next sc, (dc, ch 1, dc) all in next sc. Repeat from \* around. Sl st in 3d st of 1st 4-ch. Fasten off. Repeat Rows 6, 3 and 4.

**Top**—In White, ch 144, sl st in 1st st, ch 3, 143 dc on ch, sl st in 3-ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, dc in each dc around, sl st in 3-ch. Repeat thru Row 14. Fasten off. **ROW 15**—Sc in Gold in 1 dc, (ch 2, sc in next 3d dc) repeated around. Fasten off. Repeat Rows 3 and 4 of Base 9 times. **Edge**—With Gold, \*\* ch 1, dc in back lp of next sc, \* ch 1, (tr, ch 1, tr) in back lp of next sc. Repeat from \* twice. Ch 1, dc in next sc, ch 1, sc in next sc. Repeat from \*\* around. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Sc in White in 1st 1-ch sp on one scallop, \* (ch 3, sc in next 1-ch sp) 8 times, sc in next 1-ch sp. Repeat from \* around. Fasten off. **ROW 3**—Sc in Gold in 1st 3-ch lp, \* (ch 2, sc in next 3-ch lp) 7 times, sc in next lp. Repeat from \* around. Fasten off. Make 1 sc in Gold in each st around bottom of Top.

Make 20 Pom Pon Daisies. Sew 10 around 4th Row of Top. Sew 10 around Row 12 between those in 1st row. Line Top with satin up to base of scallops. Steam and press Base on back. Cover 2 circles of white buckram on both sides with satin and tack to Base. Sew Base to Top. Sew 6 small bone rings around top of lining.

**Cord**—Cut 4 strands each White and Gold 60" long, twist tightly, double and twist in opposite direction. Fasten loose end, run cord thru bone rings and tack ends together. Make a 2d Cord, run it thru rings from opposite side and join ends.

row. Repeat from \* 4 times. A Cluster in 2 end rows. Ch 3, turn, (a 2-dc-Cluster in next 2 dc, 1 dc in next dc) 3 times, a Cluster in 2 end dc. Ch 1, turn, sk last dc, (1 sc, 4 hdc and 1 sl st) across last row. Fasten off.

**Palm**—Repeat Rows 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 2, 3 and 4. Repeat Row 3 to \*. (Ch 1, sc in both lps of next 2d dc) 6 times, ch 17, turn, sc in 2d ch st, (ch 1, sc in next 2d ch st) 7 times, (ch 1, sc in both lps of next sc) 6 times, (ch 1, sc in back lp of next sc) 8 times. Continue in pattern as in Rows 3, 4, 5, 2 and 3, being careful to work the 8 sc in each row at wrist in back lps only. \* Ch 1, turn, sc in last sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 8 times. Repeat from \* once. Ch 1, turn, sc in last sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 7 times. Repeat this row once. Ch 2, turn, dc in last sc,

(2 dc in next sc) 6 times, 1 dc in end sc. Ch 1, turn, sc in last dc, (ch 1, sc in next 2d dc) 7 times. Ch 1, turn, sc in last sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 7 times. Fold thumb so wrong side of dc-rows is on outside of work, and crochet sides of thumb tog. with sc:—(ch 1, sc thru next 2d st on both pieces) 8 times. Ch 3, (a 2-dc-Cluster) 8 times around top edge, sl st in 1st Cluster. (Sc in next Cluster) 7 times, join and sew end tog. Sk 1 dc from base of thumb, sc in next dc, \* (ch 1, sc in next 2d dc) 15 times. \*\* Ch 1, turn, sc in last sc, (ch 1, sc in next sc) 15 times. Repeat from \*\* once. \* Ch 2, turn, 1 dc in last sc, (2 dc in next sc) 14 times, 1 dc in end sc. Ch 1, turn, sc in last dc. Repeat from \* to \*. Sew end of this part of Palm to base of Thumb. Repeat "End" of Back. Lay Back and Palm back-to-back and whip edges tog. leaving wrist open.

**Cuff**—Make 5 Blocks and join into a straight row, joining ends. On one side, repeat 1st Row of Edge on Cap. Then repeat Rows 2 and 3 of Edge on Scarf. On other side, in White, make 2 sc in each of 2 center lps on one Block, \* (1 dc and 1 tr) in next lp, sk half-lp, 1 dtr down in joining of Blocks, sk next half-lp, (1 tr and 1 dc) in next lp, (2 sc in next lp) twice. Repeat from \* around and join. Ch 1, sl st in end of one rib on wrist, (ch 1, sc back in next 3d st, ch 1, sl st in end of next rib on wrist) repeated around and fasten off. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Make 8 Pom Pons and tack around edge of Cuff. Make 2 more and tack lengthwise on center of Back.

Repeat for Left Mitten, turning Thumb and Palm opposite-side-out to reverse thumb.

(ch 1, dc in next 2 sc, ch 1, sl st in next sc) repeated around. Fasten off.

Lay Top and Under Side back-to-back and sew tog. around edge, going thru both lps of each st. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

**Pom Pom**—Wind Blue 6 times around each spoke of Winder, cut 18" long and weave center. Cut all 6 lps of each petal and rub in hands to fluff. Make 3 and sew in a group on Under Side.

**HANDBAG**—Join 30 Daisies (see Chart) as for Top of Beret. **Edge**—Repeat Row 1 of Edge on Beret Top across short side at each end of Bag piece. Join to corner B (see Chart) and repeat Edge to \*\*\*, then repeat from \* to \*\*\* once and from \* to \*\* once. 1 dc and 1 hdc in next sp, sl st in corner p. Fasten off. Repeat on remaining 3 long sides. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 of Edge.

**Gusset**—In Gray, ch 26, sk last st, 7 sc, 7 hdc and 10 dc on ch, 9 dc in end st, 10 dc, 7 hdc and 7 sc on other side of ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, turn, sc in 5 sts, hdc in 5 sts, dc in 15 sts, (2 dc in next st) 7 times, dc in 15 sts, hdc in 5 sts, sc in 5 sts. **ROW 3**—Ch 1, turn, 27 sc and 1 hdc, 5 dc in next st, 1 hdc, 4 sc and 1 hdc across end, 5 dc in next st, 1 hdc and 27 sc. Ch 1, 6 sc across end. Fasten off. Make 2.

**Tab**—In Gray, ch 8, 7 sc on ch. (Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in last sc, 1 sc in each sc across) 15 times.

**Edge**—Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in last sc, 1 sc in each sc across, 3 sc in end sc and work sc around with 3 sc in each corner. 1 more sc in 1st corner, sl st in 1st sc. Ch 1, 2 sc in same st, (make sc across with 3 sc in corner st) twice, make sc across end, 2 sc in corner, ch 10, turn, sl st back in last corner, ch 1, turn and cover lp with sc, 1 sc in same corner, make sc to next corner, join and fasten off.

**Button**—In Blue, ch 2, 6 sc in 1st st. In back lps make (2 sc in next sc) 6 times. (1 sc in next, 2 sc in next) 6 times, sc in 36 sc (3 rows). (Sk 1 sc, sc in next 2 sc) 6 times. Stuff hard with cotton and close opening with sl sts.

**Handle**—In Gray, ch 2, (3 sc, 2 hdc and 3 dc) all in 1st st. In back lps, make 1 dc in each st around and around for 14". End with 1 hdc and 1 sc and close with sl sts. Fasten off. Make two.

Pin Bag, Gussets and Tab right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Cut buckram slightly smaller than large piece. Bend it sharply crosswise 1" each side of center to form bottom of bag. Cover each side of buckram with felt, stitching tog. around edge and on each bend at bottom. Cut 3 pieces buckram to fit bottom, cover with felt and glue or stitch to bottom of lining. Sew lining inside bag. Cut buck-



# No. 23 Refreshment Set

**MATERIALS**—Lily Pearl Cotton size 5 (50-yd. balls):—3-balls White, 2-balls Lt. Green for Doily and a partial ball each Yellow, Salmon Rose, Lavender and Blue for Coasters (sufficient for Doily and 4 Coasters). Crochet hook size 7. CRAZY DAISY WINDER.

**COASTER—Daisy**—Following instructions on page 2, wind White thread around and around as in Illustration D, until there are 5 lps around each pair of spokes. Push handle of crochet hook down between petals to separate. Cut thread 24" long and weave center as in Ill. E except go under 2 petals and back over one for each st,—making a 12-petal flower with 5 lps in each petal. **Edge**—Without separating petals, make 7 sc in end of each. **ROW 2**—Sl st in 1st 4 sc, ch 3, 3 dc in same sc, holding back the last lp of each on hook, thread over and pull thru all 4 lps on hook at once (a Cluster), ch 12 and drop thread and ch in front of work, but do not cut. Working behind this lp, sl st in a color between sc in next angle between petals, ch 3, a 3-dc-Cluster in same place, ch 12 and drop this thread and ch down in front. \*\* Pick up White thread and ch and working behind colored ch, make a 4-dc-Cluster in center sc of next petal, \* ch 13, turn, sl st back in previous Cluster at starting end of 12-ch, ch 1, turn and working over both chs, cover them with 15 sc, sc in Cluster, ch 12 and drop this in front. \* Pick up colored ch and working behind White ch, make a 4-dc-Cluster between sc in next angle between petals. Repeat from

\* to \*. Repeat from \*\* around (12 White lps and 12 colored lps alternated). Cut each thread 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back. Repeat for each Coaster.

**DOILY**—Make 6 Coasters, using Green for colored lps. Tack tog. into a circle by 1 colored and 2 White lps on each side of each, leaving 3 colored and 2 White lps free on each on inside of circle between joinings. **Center**—Wind White twice around each spoke of WINDER as in Ill. C, cut 14" long and weave center as in Ill. E, making a 12-petal flower with 2 lps in each petal. **Edge**—Sc thru both lps of one petal, (ch 7, sc in next petal) 11 times, ch 7, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, sc in next lp, \* (ch 4, sc in same lp) twice, ch 4, sc in next lp. Repeat from \* around. Join with 2-ch, hdc in 1st sc. **ROW 3**—(Ch 4, sc in next lp) repeated around, with 2-ch and hdc for end lp. **ROW 4**—\*\* Ch 10, sl st in 1st Green lp to right of joining of 2 Coasters, ch 4, sl st in 1st Green lp to left of joining, ch 5, sk last 5 sts of 10-ch, dc in next st, ch 2, sl st in next 3d ch st, ch 1, sc in next 4-ch lp, ch 3, sc in next lp, \* ch 7, sl st in 1 lp of 4th ch st from hook for a p, ch 2, sl st in next White lp on Coaster, ch 5, sl st in 4th st from hook for a p, ch 2, sk previous p, sl st in next 2d ch st, ch 1, sc in next 4-ch lp, ch 3, sc in next lp. Repeat from \* once. Repeat from \*\* 5 times. Fasten off.

Stretch and pin work right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

ram to fit each Gusset. Bend lengthwise in center. Cover on one side with felt and sew on back of each Gusset. Sew a Gusset in each end of bag, going thru 1 lp of each st.

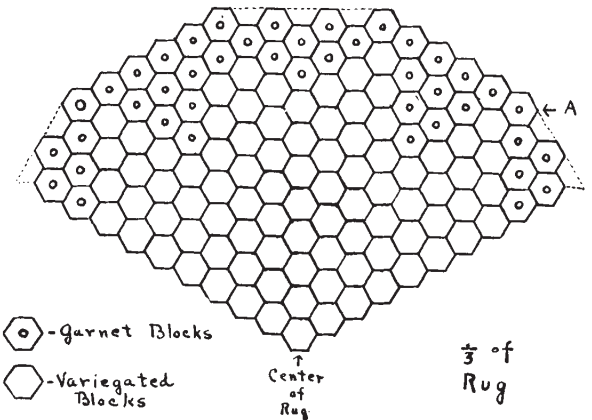

# Daisy Fluff Rug



**MATERIALS**—Jack Frost Knitting Worsted (4-fold Germantown) in 4-oz. skeins:—8-sks. Garnet and 5-sks. Variegated Rose. Crochet hook size 0. Size—38 inches. **CRAZY DAISY WINDER.**

**DAISY**—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind Variegated Rose 5 times around each spoke of Winder. Cut about 20" long and weave center as in Ill. E, making a 12-petal flower with 5 lps in each petal. With Daisy right-side-up, cut the top 4 lps in each petal, leaving only the single 5th lp uncut on back of each petal. Rub in hands to fluff into a pom pon. Make 241-Variegated Daisies and 120-Garnet Daisies.

**BLOCK**—In Garnet, ch 9, sl st in 1st st. Ch 5, dc in ring, (ch 2, dc in ring) 10 times, ch 2, sl st in 3d st of 1st 5-ch. Lay a Daisy on top of circle and make 2 sc thru the back lp of one petal into next 2-ch sp, \* (ch 1, 2 sc thru back lp of next petal into next 2-ch sp) 11 times, ch 1, sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat to \*. Ch 1, sl st in a 1-ch sp on 1st Block, ch 1, 2 sc back thru back lp of next petal into next 2-ch sp on 2d Block, (ch 1, sl st in next 1-ch sp on 1st Block, ch 1, 2 sc back thru next petal into next 2-ch sp on 2d Block) twice. Then complete row as for 1st Block.

**3d BLOCK**—Repeat 1st Block to \*. Ch 1, sl st in 2d 1-ch sp to left of joining of 1st 2 Blocks, ch 1, 2 sc back thru next petal into next 2-ch sp on 3d Block, ch 1, sl st in next 1-ch sp towards joining of 1st 2 Blocks, ch 1, 2 sc back thru next petal into next 2-ch sp on 3d Block, ch 1, sl st into joining of 1st 2 Blocks, ch 1, 2 sc back thru next petal into next 2-ch sp on 3d Block, (ch 1, sl st in next 1-ch sp on 1st Block, ch 1, 2 sc back thru next petal into next 2-ch sp on 3d Block) twice and complete 3d Block. Continue to make and join Blocks in same way (as hexagons), following Chart for placement of colors,—making 3 joinings where 2 Blocks are joined (as for Blocks 1 and 2),

# Afghan "DAISY GARDEN"

**MATERIALS**—Jack Frost Knitting Worsted (4-fold Germantown) in 4-oz. sks:—9-sks. Garnet and 4-sks. Variegated Rose. Crochet hook size 0. **CRAZY DAISY WINDER.**

Size—50" x 65".

**BLOCK**—**Flower**—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind Variegated twice around each spoke of Winder, cut end about 14" long and weave center as in Ill. E, making a 12-petal flower with 2 loops in each petal. Make 7 flowers. Each flower will have at least 2 (opposite) petals in darkest shade and at least one of the 7 flowers will have a dark center.

**Edge**—With this dark-centered flower wrong-side-up, make 1 sc in Garnet thru both lps of one dark petal, (ch 3, sc thru both lps of next petal) 11 times, ch 3, sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long and pull thru lp tight. This is the center of Block. Continue with Garnet, using Daisies wrong-side-up. Make 1 sc in 3d petal to right of a dark petal on a 2d Daisy, (ch 3, sc in next petal) twice, ch 1,

sl st in 1st sp to left of end of row on 1st Daisy, ch 1, 1 sc back in next (dark) petal on 2d Daisy, ch 1, sl st in next sp (to right of end of row) on 1st Daisy, ch 1, 1 sc back in next petal on 2d Daisy, \* ch 3, sc in next petal, ch 3, sc in 2d petal to right of a dark petal on another Daisy, ch 1, swing hook around to right, skipping last 3-ch and make sl st in next previous 3-ch, (ch 1, sc back in next petal on last Daisy, ch 1, sl st in next sp on 1st Daisy) twice, ch 1, sc back in next petal on last Daisy. Repeat from \* 4 times, joining 4 more Daisies in turn to each other and to center 1st Daisy. (Ch 1, sl st in next sp on 2d Daisy, ch 1, sl st back in next petal on 7th Daisy) twice to complete circle. \*\* (Ch 3, sc in next petal around Daisy) 6 times, ch 1, sl st in 3-ch between Daisies, ch 1, sc in next free petal. Repeat from \*\* 4 times. \*\*\* (Ch 3, sc in next petal) 6 times. Cut 6" long.

Make a 2d Block to \*\*\*. (Ch 3, sc in next petal) twice, ch 1, sl st in corresponding sp

on 2d Daisy on 1st Block, ch 1, sc back in next petal, ch 1, sl st in next sp on same Daisy on 1st Block, ch 1, sc back in next petal, (ch 3, sc in next petal) twice and cut. Make and join 8 more Blocks into a straight band.

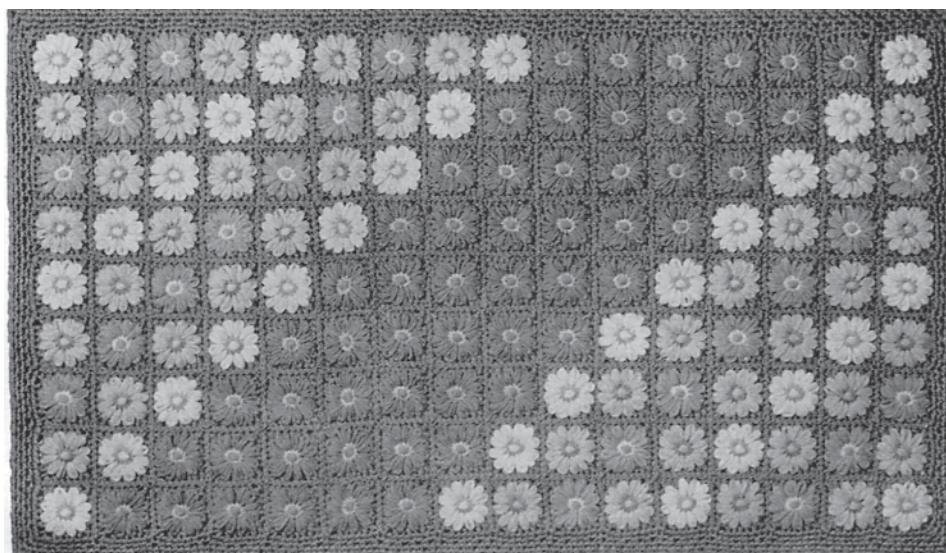
**Fill-in Daisies** — Following directions for Variegated Daisies, make 14 Daisies in Garnet. With Garnet and holding all work wrong-side-up, make sc in one petal, (ch 3, sc in next petal) 4 times. Now join remaining 8 petals with 1-chs to 4 Daisies around an opening on one side of Band, fastening to two 3-ch sps on each Daisy. Fill in the 9 openings on each side of Band in same way.

**Border**—With right-side-up, sc in Garnet in center sc at one end, \*\* 3 sc in next sp, sc in sc, \* 3 sc in next sp, hdc in next sc, dc in next sp, (tr in next sc, dtr down in bottom of angle, tr in next sc) holding back the last lp of each st on hook, yarn over and pull thru all 4 lps at once (a Cluster made), dc in next sp, hdc in next sc, \*\* (3 sc in next sp, sc in sc) 3 times. Repeat from \* to \*\*. Repeat from \*\* to \*\* around Band, working around ends as at start of row, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in sl st for a widening, 1 sc in back lp of each st around with 3 widenings around each end. Join to 1st sc. **ROW 3**—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in back lp of each sc around, with 6 widenings around each end. Join and cut. Thread each 6-ch end to a needle and fasten securely on back.

Make 7 Bands and sew together exactly matching patterns, going thru 1 lp of each sc.

**Edge**—In Garnet, with wrong-side-up, make a row of sc in back lps, widening 3 times around each point. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, turn and in back lps, sc in 4 sc, (ch 3, sc in next 4 sc) repeated around, skipping 2 sc in angle between points. Join and fasten off.

Stretch and pin afghan right-side-down on a large, padded table or board, or on quilting or curtain frames. Steam and press dry thru a cloth (see Blocking Instruction on page 31).



## No. 26 Rug "GARDEN GAY"

**MATERIALS**—Lily Rug Yarn Art. 241 (80-yd. skeins):—13-sks. Lt. Blue, 2-sks. Peach and 1-sk. each Salmon Rose and Cream. Crochet hook size H-6. CRAZY DAISY WINDER.

Size—24" x 40".

**BLOCK**—Daisy—Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind yarn twice around each spoke of Winder. Cut 1" long and weave center with a contrasting color as in Ill. E.

**Base**—In Lt. Blue ch 10, sl st in 1st st. (Ch 3, 3 sc in ring) 4 times. Sl st in next 3-ch lp, ch 3, 1 hdc in same lp, \* hdc in next 3 sc, (1 hdc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 hdc) all in next 3-ch. Repeat from \* twice. Hdc in next 4 sts, ch 1, sl st in 2d st of next 3-ch. Cut 8" long. Lay Daisy on top of Base and tack tip of each petal down, using carpet warp for the Peach, Salmon Rose and Cream Daisies, and the Rug Yarn in Lt. Blue for the Blue Daisies. Make 144 Blocks. Using 8" end left from each Base, sew Blocks tog. into strips, going thru both lps of each st, then sew strips tog. exactly matching corners.

Starting at left corner of one end, make

corner Block of Cream Daisy with Salmon Rose center. Make the next diagonal row of 2 Blocks, Peach Daisies with Blue centers. **Next Row**—3 Blocks of Salmon Rose Daisies with Cream Centers. **4th Row**—4 Blocks of Peach Daisies with Blue centers. **5th Row**—5 Blocks of Cream Daisies with Salmon Rose centers. **6th Row**—6 Blocks of Peach Daisies with Blue centers. **7th Row**—7 Blocks of Salmon Rose Daisies with Cream centers. **8th Row**—8 Blocks of Peach Daisies with Blue centers. **9th Row**—9 Blocks of Cream Daisies with Salmon Rose centers. Repeat this section for other diagonal corner of rug. Then connect the 2 sections with 6 rows of Blocks,—Blue Daisies with Peach centers,—9 Blocks in each row.

**BORDER**—In Lt. Blue, work sc around rug, 9 sc across each Block, with 3 sc in each corner of rug. **ROW 2**—Make (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner, with (ch 1, sc in next 2d sc) repeated around. **ROW 3**—Make (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner 2-ch, with (ch 1, sc in next 1-ch sp) repeated around. Repeat for 4th Row. Fasten off.

Stretch and pin rug right-side-down on a large, padded board or table. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

5 joinings where a Block is joined to 2 other Blocks (as for 3d Block), or 7 joinings where a Block is joined to 3 other Blocks.

**EDGE**—In Garnet, sc in 1-ch sp at "A" on Chart, (sc in next 2 sc, 1 sc in 1-ch sp) 3 times, \* hdc in next 2d sc, dc between Blocks, hdc in next 2d sc, (sc in next 1-ch sp, sc in next 2 sc) twice, sc in next 1-ch sp. Repeat from \* 4 times. \*\* Sc in next 2 sc, sc in 1-ch sp, sc in next sc, dc in next

1-ch sp, tr in next 2d sc, dtr in next 2 sc on next Block, dtr in next 1-ch sp, dtr in next 2 sc, tr in next 2d sc on next Block, dc in next sc, sc in next sc, sc in next 1-ch sp, sc in next 2 sc, sc in next 1-ch sp. Repeat from \*\* twice. (Sc in next 2 sc, sc in 1-ch sp) twice. Repeat from \* around rug and fasten off.

On each of the 18 sps around rug marked with dotted lines, tie a tuft:—Wind 2 strands

of Garnet 20 times around a 1" card. Cut at one edge. Thread a long strand of Garnet to a large needle and take a st in center of one sp. Pull end down to 2½". Take a 2d st alongside and pull down, leaving a lp between. Pass 40-strand tuft thru lp, pull tie strand down tightly around tuft and tie in a hard, double knot. Cut ends even with tuft. Fluff to match pom pons. Repeat in other 17 sps.





## No. 27 Buffet Supper Scarf

**MATERIALS**—Lily FROST-TONE (600-yd. cones):—  
1½-cones White, Cream or Ecu. Crochet hook size  
10. CRAZY DAISY WINDER. Size—15" x 44".

**BLOCK**—(Size—2¾") — Daisy — Following instructions on page 2, Illustration C, wind 4 times around spokes 1 and 2, once each around spokes 3 and 4, 5 and 6, 4 times around spokes 7 and 8, and once each around spokes 9 and 10, 11 and 12. Cut 14" long and weave center as in Ill. E. **Edge**—(Sc, hdc and 5 dc) in all 4 lps of one 4-lp petal, \* ch 7, sl st back in 3d dc, ch 1, 2 sc in lp, ch 4, sl st in last sc for a p, \*\* (3 sc, a 7-ch p, 3 sc, a 4-ch p, 1 sc and 1 sl st) all in bal. of 7-ch lp, (2 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc) in same petal, ch 5, sc in 2 lps of 4th ch st from hook for a p, ch 2, sc in single lp of next petal, ch 5, sc in single lp of next petal, ch 5, p, ch 2, (sc, hdc and 5 dc) in 4 lps of next petal. Repeat from \* around. Join final p-lp to 1st sc, cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Repeat to \*\* in Edge Row. 3 sc in lp, ch 3, sl st in a corner p on 1st Block, ch 3, sl st back

in 1st of 3 Clusters in corner, ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, a 2-tr-Cluster in next 2d Cluster, ch 5, a Cluster, ch 3, sc in end 3-ch. Fasten off. Repeat in other front corner. **ROW 2**—Join to top corner p at neck, (ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, sc in next p around neck) 6 times, ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, dc in next p, ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, sc in 3-ch at end of last row, (ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, dc between next 2 Clusters) twice, ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, sk next Cluster, sc in next 3-ch, ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, dc in next p, ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, sc in next p, ch 5, a Cluster, ch 1, sc in joining

of Blocks. Complete row in same way, reversing directions.

Stretch and pin work right-side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Cut Back of net or cloth with a 6" opening from neck down center. Fasten neck with a lp and button. Sew Back to Vestee at shoulders. Tack a 12" ribbon at side of each piece at waistline.

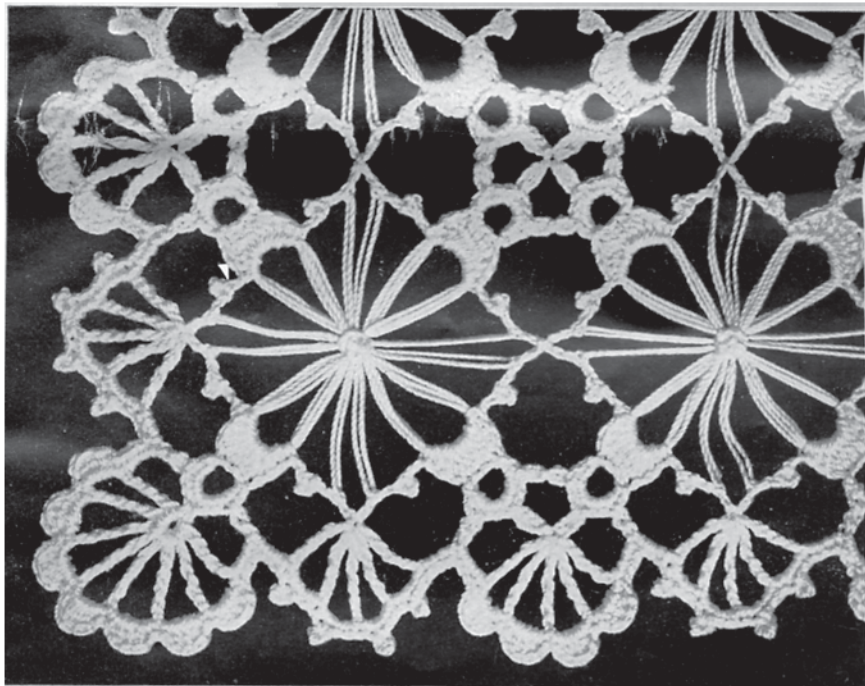

in last sc, 3 sc in lp, ch 2, sl st in next p on 1st Block, ch 2, sl st back in last sc, 1 sc and 1 sl st in bal. of lp, (2 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc) in same petal, ch 5, p, ch 2, sc in next petal, ch 2, sl st in center 5-ch lp on 1st Block, ch 2, sc back in next petal, ch 5, p, ch 2, (sc, hdc and 5 dc) in next petal, ch 7, sl st back in 3d dc, ch 1, 2 sc in lp, ch 2, sl st in corresponding p on 1st Block, ch 2, sl st back in last sc, 3 sc in lp, ch 3, sl st in next (corner) p on 1st Block, ch 3, sl st back in last sc and complete Block.

Continue to make and join Blocks 5 wide by 16 long (or other desired size).

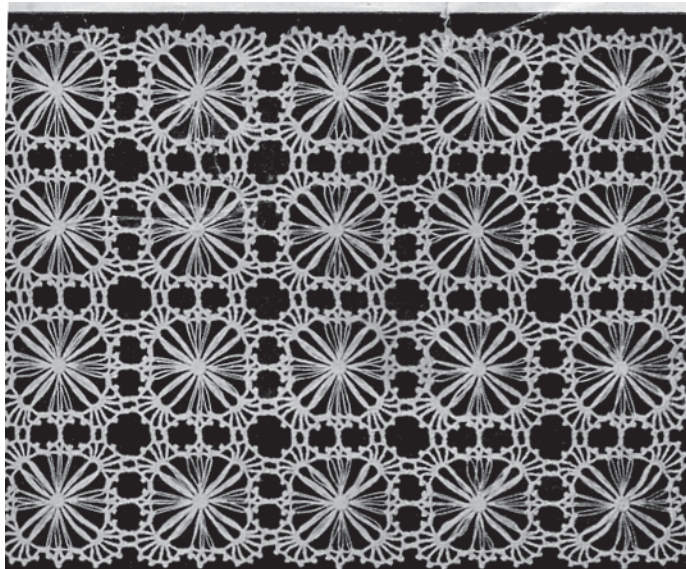
**EDGE**—Join to 1st p at one corner, (ch 3, dtr) 8 times in corner p, \* ch 3, sc in next p, (ch 3, dtr) 5 times in center st of 5-ch sp on side of next Block, ch 3, sc in 1st p on next corner of Block, (ch 3, dtr) 5 times in joining of Blocks. Repeat from \* around with each corner like 1st one. **ROW 2**—3 sc in next 3-ch sp, (1 sc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1 and 1 sc,—all in next 3-ch sp) 7 times, \* (3 sc in next sp) twice, (2 sc, ch 4, sl st in last sc for a p, and 2 sc) in each of next 4 sps, (3 sc in next sp) twice, (1 sc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1 and 1 sc,—all in next 3-ch sp) 4 times. Repeat from \* around with each corner like 1st one. Fasten off.

Stretch and pin scarf right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

# Daisy TABLE DOILY SET

## "Dinner Date"

**MATERIALS**—Lily SKYTONE Mercerized Crochet Cotton (250-yd. balls):—4 balls White, Cream or Ecru (sufficient for Centerpiece, 4 place Mats and 4 Coasters). Crochet hook size 10. CRAZY DAISY WINDER.

**BLOCK—Daisy**—Following instructions on page 2, wind thread from left to right around spokes Nos. 1 and 2 as given in Illustration D, across center and from left to right around spokes 3 and 12, across center and repeat 4 times in same way around same spokes. (Cross center and wind from right to left around spoke No. 11, cross center and wind from left to right around spoke No. 10) 3 times. (Cross center and wind from right to left around spokes Nos. 8 and 7, cross center and wind from right to left around spokes Nos. 6 and 9) 5 times. Cross center, holding thread in center with thumb (and wind from right to left around spoke No. 4, cross center and wind from left to right around spoke No. 5, cross center) 3 times. Cut 24" long and weave 3 rows of sts around center, making an 8-petal flower with 5-lp petals alternating with 3-lp petals. **Edge**—Sc in 1 lp of a 3-lp petal, \* (ch 3, sc in next lp of same petal) twice, ch 6, 6 sc thru all 5 lps of next petal, ch 6, sc in 1 lp of next 3-lp petal. Repeat from \* around. Join with 6-ch, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—\* Ch 4, sc thru 2 lps of starting st of 4-ch, ch 1 (a p-lp made), (1 dc, another p-lp and 1 dc) all in next sc, a p-lp, sl st in next sc, 3 sc on half of next 6-ch lp, (a p-lp, tr in next sc) 6 times, a p-lp, 3 sc on left half of next 6-ch lp, sl st in next sc. Repeat from \* around. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

**2d BLOCK**—Join to 1st Block by the 5th and 6th ps on 1st corner shell, by the center p on small shell and by the 2d and 3d ps on next corner shell,—joining to corresponding ps on 1st Block. To join, instead of making a p-lp, ch 3, sl st in p on 1st Block, ch 2, sc back in starting st of 3-ch and ch 1. Repeat for each joining.

**CENTERPIECE**—(Size—12½")—Make and join 16 Blocks 4 x 4 into a square.

**PLACE MAT**—(Size—12½" x 16")—Make and join 20 Blocks 4 x 5. Make 4.

**COASTER**—Make 4 of one Block each.

Stretch and pin Doilies right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

## BLOCKING INSTRUCTIONS

After a piece of crochet is finished, stretch and pin it right-side-down on a padded ironing board and steam with a wet cloth and hot iron. Then press thru a dry cloth until thoroughly dry. For large articles, stretch on curtain or quilting frames, lay over an ironing board, and steam and press dry in sections until completed. Be sure to pin out all picots, loops, scallops, etc., around outside edges.

It's always important to use the particular yarn specified in crochet directions. In the directions using the Crazy Daisy Winder it is essential to make sure your crochet fits correctly around the Crazy Daisies.
