# SOUTHERN RAILWAY SYSTEM

## Southern Railway System Textile Directory

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THIS directory of textile manufacturing plants in territory served by Southern Railway System includes all of the plants completed and put in operation up to January 1, 1929. It also lists all of the new plants and important additions to plants under construction on that date.

This edition of the Directory lists 1,182 textile manufacturing plants of all kinds, operating 13,814,748 spindles, 273,599 looms and 57,763 knitting machines. During the year 1928, the additions to textile manufacturing machinery in the territory served directly by Southern Railway System lines amounted to 87,492 spindles, 2,749 looms and 2,914 knitting machines. During the year, including those under construction at the end of the year, 143 additions were made to existing plants.

Since 1911 southern cotton mills have, in each year, led those of all the other states in the consumption of cotton. In 1926, the South passed New England in the number of spindles installed and in 1927 definitely took the lead over all other parts of the United States, including New England, in cotton manufacturing capacity.

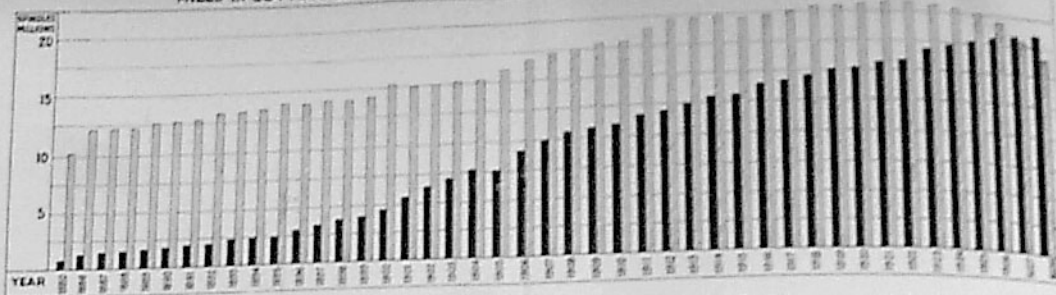
The United States Census Bureau reports that on January 1, 1929, there were installed in cotton mills in the United States a total of 35,264,646 spindles, of which 18,615,264 were in the mills in the Southern States. As of that date the South had 1,966,522 more spindles than the other states, or 52.79 per cent of all the machinery engaged in spinning cotton in the United States.

The continued southward movement of the cotton textile industry is shown by the fact that there was a net increase of 224,912 spindles in the South and a net decrease of 1,426,842 spindles in all other states in 1928.

Massachusetts, with 9,109,084, still leads all other states in the number of spindles installed, but North Carolina, with 6,196,208 spindles, and South Carolina, with 5,512,250 spindles, each exceeded Massachusetts in the number of spindle hours worked during the year.

### COTTON SPINDLES IN UNITED STATES MILLS—YEARS 1880—1928

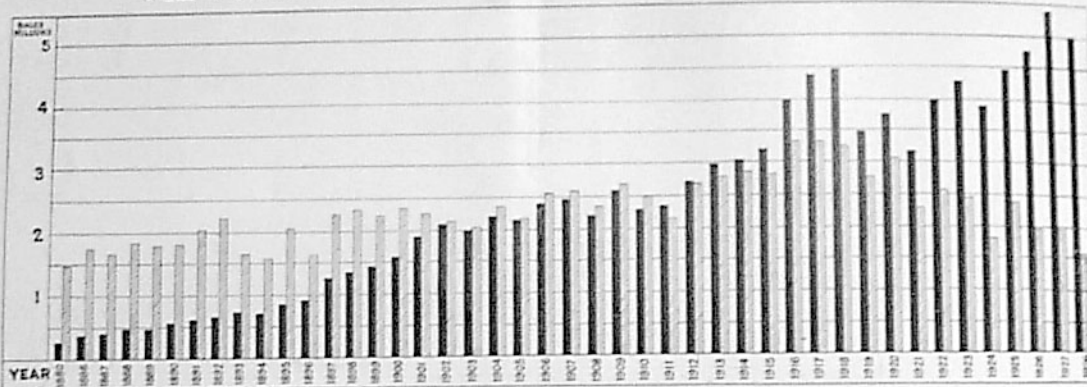
MILLS IN COTTON GROWING STATES —      MILLS IN ALL OTHER STATES ■■



The above diagram shows the growth of the cotton textile industry in the South as compared with other parts of the United States since 1880. The solid black columns represent the number of spindles in mills in cotton-producing states and the shaded columns the number in the mills in all other states. It will be noted that since 1880, when the cotton-producing states had only a very small proportion (5.27 per cent) of the total spindles in the United States, there has been a steady, almost uniform, increase from year to year, and that the number of spindles in other states reached a maximum in 1922, with a decrease in each subsequent year. The net decrease since 1922 outside of the South has been 4,364,632 spindles, as compared with a net increase of 2,443,327 in the South in the same period.

The above diagram shows the consumption of cotton in southern mills since 1880, as compared with the consumption in the mills in all other states.

In 1928 southern mills took 5,000,439 bales, or 76.04 per cent of the total cotton consumption of the United States, while mills in all other states took only 1,575,246 bales, or 23.96 per cent of the cotton consumed. This is accounted for, in part, by the fact that in 1928 the southern mills, with 18,615,284 spindles in place, operated 64,177,998,410 spindle-hours, while the mills in other states, with 16,648,762 spindles in place, operated 28,565,971,677 spindle-hours. In other words, southern mills, with 52.79 per cent of the spindles, worked 69.20 per cent of the total spindle-hours in that year.

## The Map Tells The Story

The opposite map shows in a graphic way the present development of the textile industry in territory served by Southern Railway System, also its relation to the coal fields of the South and the electric power transmission lines.

The locations of spindles are indicated by red characters on the map. On a map of this size it is impossible to put all of the characters immediately at the individual cities and towns where the spindles are located. In fact, especially in the more congested parts of the territory, it is not possible to show all of the towns at which there are textile mills. For this reason, in the more congested areas, the plan has been followed of so grouping the characters as to show the general geographical distribution of the industry. Detailed information as to each city and town and as to each plant will be found in the tables in which the plants are listed.

The red characters represent 13,814,748 textile spindles of all kinds, of which 13,644,964 are cotton spindles, representing 73.30 per cent of all the cotton spindles in the cotton-growing states. The total spindles shown include 111,164 in woolen and worsted mills and 58,620 in silk mills.

### Where Cotton Manufacturing is Profitable

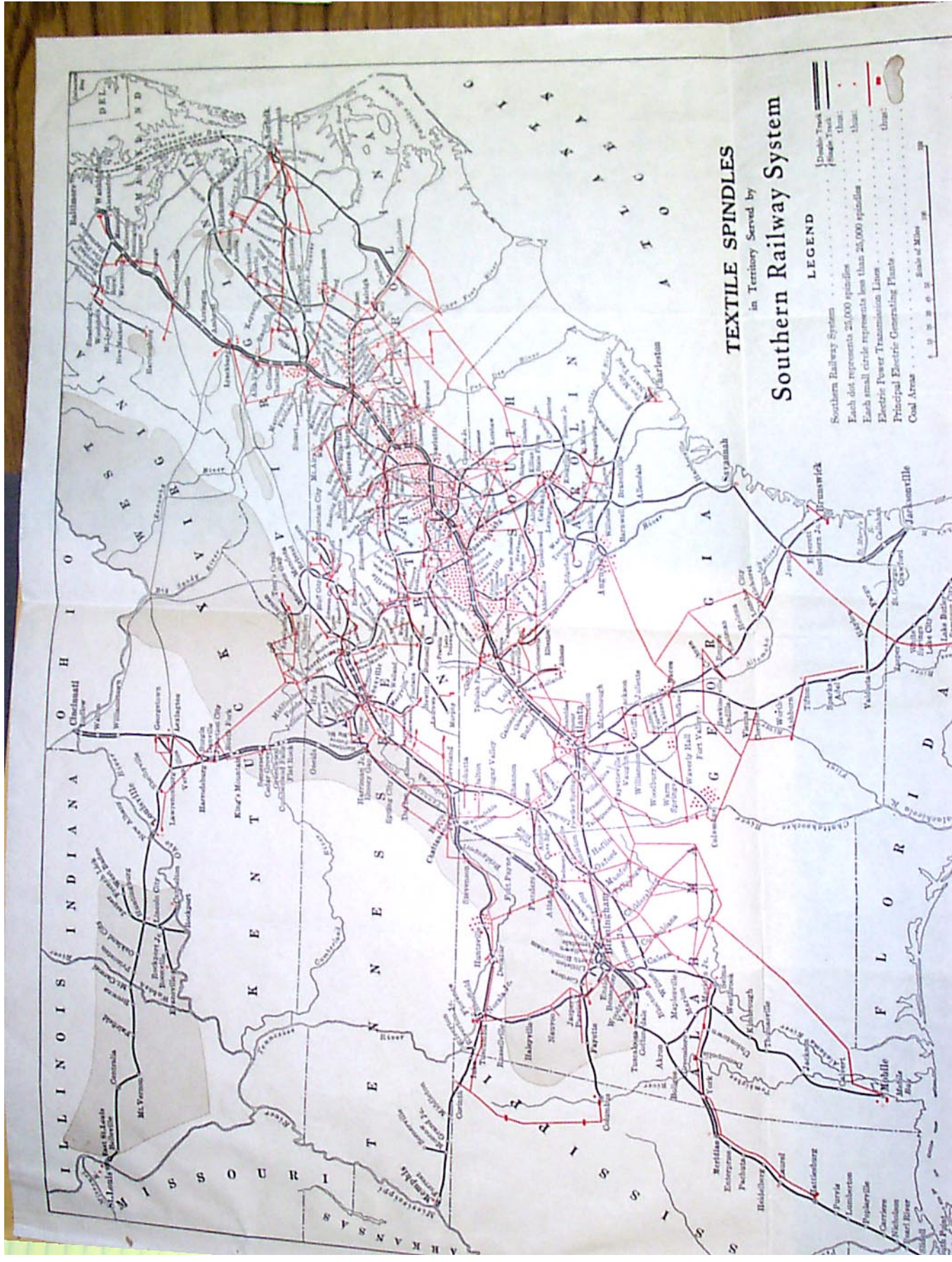
The map shows that the geographical location of Southern Railway is most advantageous for the concentration of cotton from all parts of the cotton belt and for the distribution of manufactured products. It also shows that the territory served by the System is well located with reference to electric power and to coal for power and heat.

Due to the shorter haul from the mine, coal delivered on southern mill sidings is cheaper in proportion to power produced than either coal or fuel oil in the New England and North Atlantic states.

The Railroad traverses and surrounds the Southern Appalachian and Piedmont sections containing the principal hydro-electric power developments of the South, and the territory is covered by a network of power transmission lines. The transmission lines of the principal companies are inter-connected, forming a great super-power zone in which deficiencies of power in any one locality are supplied by surpluses from other localities. The electric power situation is constantly being strengthened by bringing in new hydro-electric powers and by building large steam power plants, supplementing water power and maintaining service during periods of low water.

Climatic conditions are unexcelled. Winters are short and mild. Outdoor operations can be carried on practically every day in the year. Snow and ice do not impede traffic or prevent employees from reaching their work on time. The influences of the Appalachian Mountain ranges, the Atlantic Ocean and the Gulf of Mexico upon the climate are such that summer heat is not excessive. In much of the territory hot nights in summer are unknown.

Labor is efficient and adaptable. The white population is descended almost entirely from colonial stock, 94.98 per cent of the white people in the territory being of native parentage on both sides, as compared with 55.82 per cent for all other states.
