

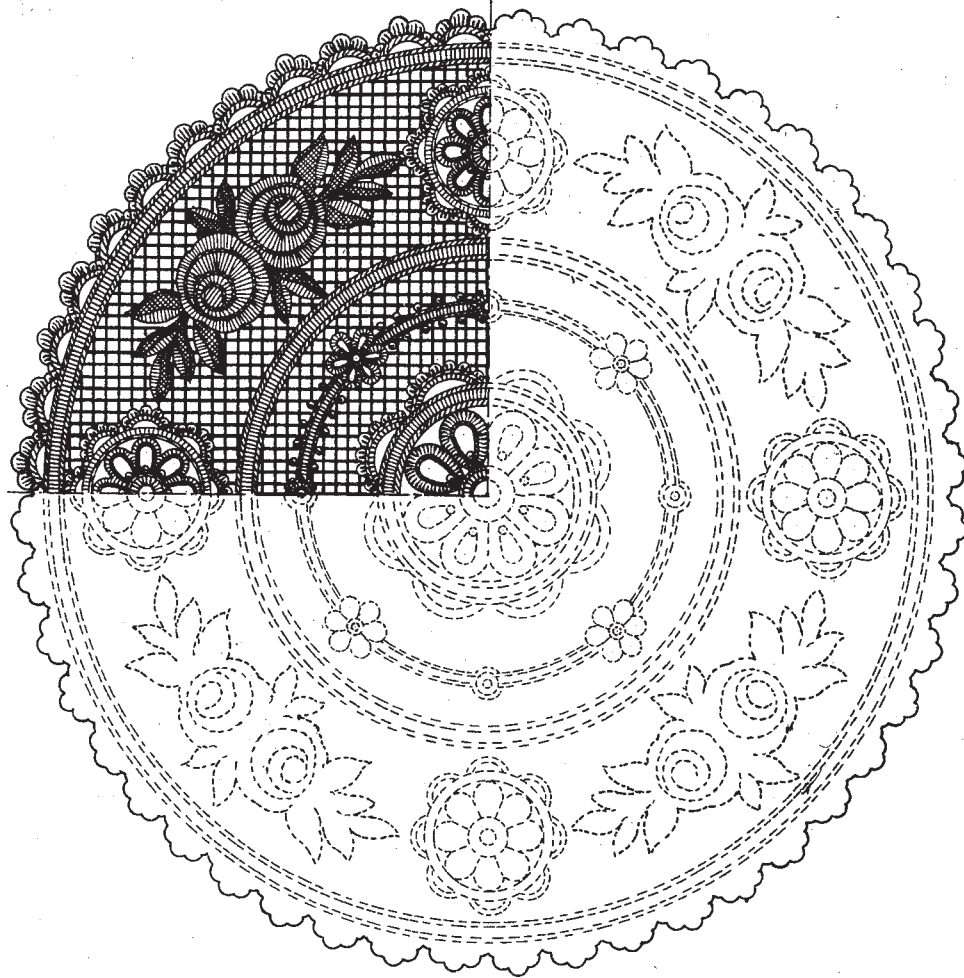

DESIGN FOR A DOILY

Application filed March 15, 1930. Serial No. 34,901. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I EDWARD KARFIOL, a citizen of the United States, residing in Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Doily, of which the following is a specification, reference being made to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which the figure represents a face view of a doily showing my new design.

The full lines of the drawing shows one-quarter of the design in detail, it being understood that the balance is a mere repeat of the part now shown by the dotted lines and that the full line indicates the outline of the border.

I claim:—
