

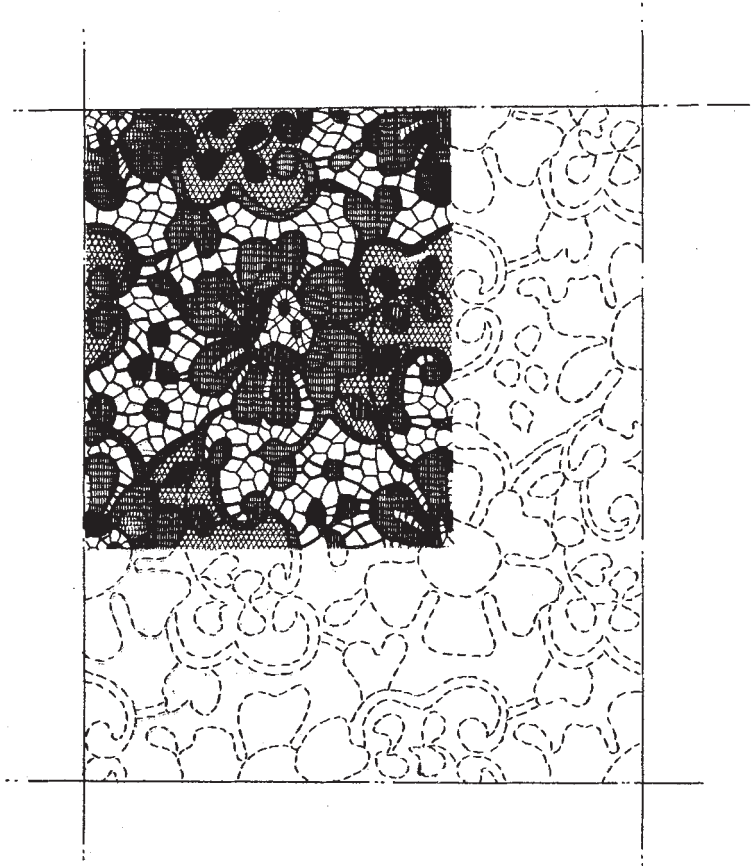

DESIGN FOR LACE

Application filed July 1, 1929. Serial No. 31,907. Term of patent 3½ years.
