

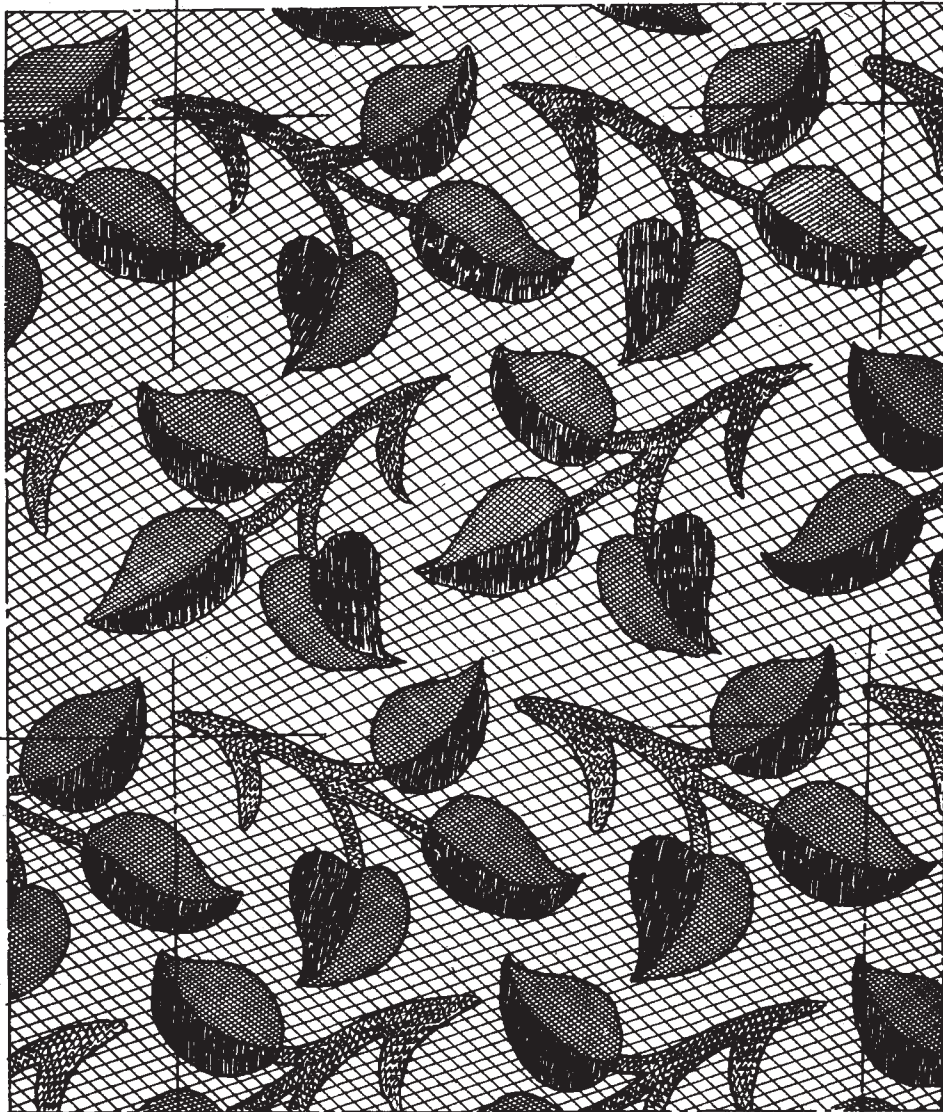

DESIGN FOR SPANISH LACE FOR DRESSES

Application filed August 27, 1929. Serial No. 32,560. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES B. J. MOLITOR, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Spanish Lace for Dresses, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
