

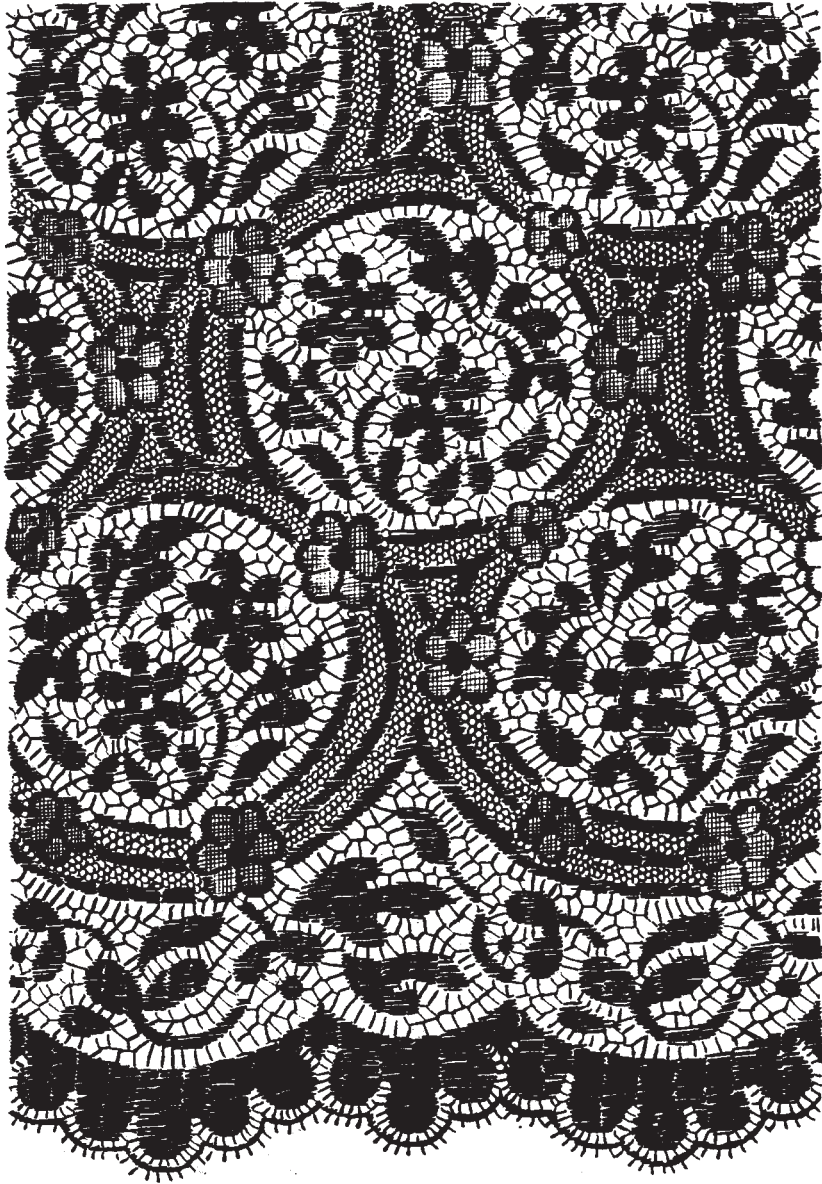

### DESIGN FOR LACE

Application filed September 5, 1930. Serial No. 36,878. Term of patent 3½ years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GEORGE M. DICKEN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Hulmeville, Bucks County, and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lace, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The drawing illustrates a piece of lace showing my new design. The upper edge of the design merges into a straight selvage.
